AN ORDINANCE *MD-930*

An ordinance accepting proposal of Elder Construction Company for constructing sanitary sewers Contract Sec. No. 65 and authorizing contract and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. (Acceptance) That the City does hereby accept the attached written proposal of the party named in the caption hereof, dated November 15, 1920 and offering to construct sanitary sewers in Knob Hill District, Contract Section No. 65 in and for said City in accordance with the written specifications and description and drawings prepared and submitted by the City Engineer provided said party making said proposal shall strictly comply with all requirements made by or under the provisions of this ordinance and all instruments herein referred to, which are made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. (Appropriation) That to defray the costs and expenses to be paid by the City by reason of the premises, the sum of Twenty Three Thousand Dollars or as much thereof as may be necessary, shall be and the same is hereby appropriated out of Sanitary sewer funds derived from the sale of bonds of this city dated September 1, 1919, and said funds so appropriated shall be kept in a separate account to be designated as special fund for constructing sanitary sewers in Contract Section No. 65.


