BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

AN ORDINANCE

1. WHEREAS, it is necessary to the carrying out of the policies promulgated by the Civil Works Administration, that real estate and the improvements thereon be made available for use by such

Administration for the purpose of a cannery where beef may be canned and such products be distributed among the indigent and needy; and,

2. WHEREAS, as a condition precedent to the use of said land and improvements by the Public Works Administration that the operation and maintenance of such plant be an enterprise of purely public charity as contemplated by the Statutes of the State of Texas in respect of such matters; and,

3. WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, in order to effectively carry out the policies declared by the Civil Works Administration, deem it advisable that all such land and improvements so devoted to the purpose above described shall be exempt from taxation; NOW, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

4. That Lots Numbers Five (5) and Six (6), in City Block Two Thousand, Eight Hundred and Ten (2810), and the improvements thereon, situated within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, and the use of which is to be devoted to the use by the Public Works Administration as a beef cannery, the products of such beef cannery to be made available for distribution among the indigent and needy, shall be exempt from taxation from June 1, 1933 to May 31, 1934.
