AN ORDINANCE

Approving report and roll filed by the City Engineer, with reference to the widening and straightening of SOUTH ALAMO STREET, between its intersection with the South property line of E. Commerce Street and the north property line of E. Market Street.

WHEREAS, the City Commissioners heretofore, by Resolution ordered the improvement of SOUTH ALAMO STREET, between its intersection with the south line of East Commerce Street, and the north line of East Market Street; and,

WHEREAS, said improvements are generally described as follows, to-wit: The widening and straightening of said street between said point by setting back the property lines thereof, removing such improvements as exist between said lines, and acquiring such property as may be required for the purpose; and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has, in accordance with the Improvement Ordinance, filed with the Commission, his report, containing the plans and specification covering the proposed improvements, together with the statement of the cost of same, the names of the property owners abutting thereon, the description of the said property and the amount to be assessed against such owners and said property as their or its proportion of the cost of the making of such improvements, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That a public necessity exists for the widening and straightening of said South Alamo Street, between the points aforementioned, and that the roll and report of the City Engineer, with plans and other documents attached thereto are hereby approved and adopted and

the new lines of said street are hereby designated as shown upon such plans and said improvement is hereby ordered made.

SECTION TWO: That in the opinion of the Commission it is necessary and proper to assess a part of the cost of said improvements against the owners of property abutting thereon and against their property, and it is so ordered.

SECTION THREE: That as appears from said roll and report as here now approved by the Commission, the total amount proposed to be assessed against the owners of abutting property is \$78,444.00 Dollars; that the amount per front foot to be assessed against such property owners on an average is estimated to be \$200.00 Dollars.

SECTION FOUR: That a hearing be given the owners of the said abutting property, and to all persons interested therein or having a lien thereon, their agents and attorneys, before the City Commission of the City of San Antonio, which hearing shall begin on the 19th day of December, 1927, at 10 o'clock A. M. and shall be held in the City Council Chamber of said City, and at which hearing all of said owners or other interested persons, their agents or attorneys, desiring to contest the said improvements or assessments proposed to be made against them, or the regularity of any proceeding with reference thereto, or any other matter in connection therewith, shall appear and be heard, and at which hearing any of such parties shall have the right to appear in person or by attorney, and to produce testimony to be fully heard; that the said hearing shall be continued from time to time and day to day until a fair opportunity has been offered to all desiring to be heard; that the said hearing shall be held in accordance with the IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE of the City and the law of the State, and that at the termination thereof the said Commission will determine, from the evidence before it, the several amounts intended to be assessed against said persons and their property and will so assess same. No assessment will be made against any person his or her property in excess of the benefits in enhanced value thereof arising from the making of the said improvements.

SECTION FIVE: That all of said owners and other interested parties are hereby referred for further information to the proceedings with reference to the said improvements on file with the City Clerk of San Antonio and particularly to the roll and report of the said City Engineer on file in the office of the City Clerk.

SECTION SIX: That the City Clerk is directed to give notice of the said hearing to the owners of the said property, their agents and attorneys, and other interested parties, by publishing a copy of this Ordinance three times, attested by him, in the San Antonio Evening News, newspaper of general circulation published in the City of San Antonio, the first of which publications shall be more than ten days before the date set for the said hearing; and is further directed to give notice hereof by serving the said owners, if known, or their agents or attorneys if the address of the said owner shall be unknown, with a copy of this ordinance either by registered letter posted in the post office of the City of San Antonio more than ten days prior to the hearing or by messenger. Said personal service, ^{however} to be merely cumulative and in addition to said notice by publication, which shall, without said personal notice, be valid and binding.

AN ORDINANCE

Approving report and roll filed by the City Engineer, with reference to the widening and straightening of MAIN AVENUE, between its intersection with the north line of West Travis and the South Line of West Martin Streets, together with attached documents.

WHEREAS, the City Commissioners heretofore, by Resolution, ordered the improvement of Main Avenue, between its intersections with the north line of West Travis Street, and the south line of West Martin Street, and,

WHEREAS, said improvements are generally described as follows: to-wit: The widening and straightening of said street between said points by setting back the property lines thereof, removing such improvements as exist between said lines, and acquiring such property as may be required for the purpose; and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has, in accordance with the Improvement Ordinance, filed with the Commission, his report, containing the plans and specifications covering the proposed improvements, together with the statement of the cost of same, the names of the property owners abutting thereon, the description of the said property and the amount to be assessed against such owners and said property as their or its proportion of the cost of the making of such improvements, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That a public necessity exists for the widening and straightening of said MAIN AVENUE, between the point aforementioned, and that the roll and report of the City Engineer, with plans and other documents attached thereto are hereby approved and adopted and the new lines of said street are hereby designated as shown upon such plans and said improvement is hereby ordered made.

SECTION TWO: That in the opinion of the Commission it is necessary and proper to assess a part of the cost of said improvements against the owners of property abutting thereon and against their property, and it is so ordered.

SECTION THREE: That as appears from said roll and report as here now approved by the Commission, the total amount proposed to be assessed against the owners of abutting property is \$246,440.00 Dollars; that the amount per front foot to be assessed against such property owners on an average is estimated to be \$200.00 Dollars.

SECTION FOUR: That a hearing be given the owners of the said abutting property, and to all persons interested therein or having a lien thereon, their agents and attorneys, before the City Commission of the City of San Antonio, which hearing shall begin on the 19th day of 19th day of December 1927, at 10 O'clock A. M. and shall be held in the City Council Chamber of said City, and at which hearing all of said owners or other interested persons, their agents or attorneys, desiring to contest the said improvements or assessments proposed to be made against them, or the regularity of any proceeding with reference thereto, or any other matter in connection therewith, shall appear and be heard, and at which hearing any of such parties shall have the right to appear in person or by attorney, and to produce testimony to be fully heard; that the said hearing shall be continued from time to time and day to day until a fair opportunity has been offered to all desiring to be heard; that the said hearing shall be held in accordance with the IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE of the City and the law of the State, and that at the termination thereof the said Commission will determine, from the evidence before it, the several amounts intended to be assessed against said persons and their property and will so assess same. AN ORDINANCE

MH-578

DECLARING A NUISANCE THE PLANT AND OPERATION THEREOF, OF THE GRAYBURG OIL COMPANY, ON THE EAST SIDE OF CONCEPCION ROAD, MORE PARTICULARLY HEREIN DESCRIBED, AND DIRECTING ITS ABATEMENT.

It appearing to the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that the plant of the Grayburg Oil Company on the premises bounded on the west by Concepcion Road, on the north and northeast by the San Antonio and Aransas Pass Railway Company's track and right-of-way, and on the south by property of the Alamo Dressed Beef Company, in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, is being operated in such a manner as to emanate gases and foul odors thus making living conditions in the district surrounding it, unhealthy and dangerous and a menace to the public health, and public welfare and comfort; that said plant and its operation have increased the fire hazard in the neighborhood, and the same is dangerous and a menace to the public safety; that by reason of said plant and its operation, property values in the neighborhood have been decreased; and the continued existence and operation thereof is a continuing nuisance; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That said plant of said Grayburg Oil Company, and the operation thereof, be and the same is hereby declared to be a nuisance, and the same is ordered to be abated.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That a certified copy of this ordinance is immediately served upon the President or Secretary of said Grayburg Oil Company, by leaving the same at the office of said Company, in the City of San Antonio, Texas, during reasonable business hours; and that said plant be removed from said premises within ten (10) days, and its operation be immediately discontinued.
