

AN ORDINANCE

ORDERING AN ELECTION ON THE 8TH., DAY OF
MAY, 1951, FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That an election be, and the same is ordered hereby to be held in the City of San Antonio, on Tuesday, the 8th., day of May, A. D., 1951, for the general municipal election of the following municipal officers, to-wit:

Mayor; Commissioner of Taxation; Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks and Public Property; Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements; and, Commissioner of Fire and Police.

2. Said election shall be held as prescribed by law, at the following polling or voting places in the several election precincts of the City of San Antonio, between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M., Central Standard Time:-

3. Voting at said election shall be done by the use of voting machines; and, the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio do determine hereby that voting machines shall be used for the casting of absentee votes at this election, and a voting machine shall be put in the office of the City Clerk in the City Hall at San Antonio, Texas; and, the City Clerk, or any assistant clerk, is charged to perform the functions provided by law in the casting of absentee ballots and shall hold such election, and ballots shall be cast at any time not more than 20 days nor less than 3 days prior to the date of this election; all in the manner made and provided by the statutes of the State of Texas on this subject.

4. The Mayor shall be authorized to issue a Proclamation and Notice of Election substantially in the form hereof, and he is directed to cause such Proclamation and Notice of Election to be published and promulgated by posting one copy thereof in each of said election precincts at the polling place specified and cause the same to be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of San Antonio, in the time and manner prescribed by law.
