

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, DECEMBER 5TH, A.D.1921, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable O. B. Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation:
C.W.Taylor, for refund of taxes.
Chas. R. Stewart, for cancellation of taxes.
Wilson O. Russell, for correction of assessment.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Impts.
Citizens of Denver Boulevard, requesting that street be repaired.
A.I.Root Co. requesting that telephone pole be removed from 537 S.Flores Street.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police:
For arc lamp at Webb, Ada and S.Presa Streets.
E.F.Kneuppe, for permit to install gasoline pump and tank 514 River Avenue.
Mrs Ada Davis, requesting permit to extend sewer connection, was read and referred to City Engineer.

Petition to have name of Laver Street and McKinney Place changed to E.Woodlawn Avenue, was read the second time, and laid over.

Communication from property owners in Lakeview Addition, thanking the Mayor and Commissioners for refusing permit for erection of sanitarium, was read and ordered filed.

Petition of Club Protector Mexico-Texano, protesting against taking jitneys off of streets was read and ordered filed.

Petition of Mexican Blue Cross for use of Market Hall December 17, 1921, was read and granted.

Commissioner Wright made the following recommendations, which were adopted:
S.G.Lucchese, for permit to erect electric sign, granted.
Casseb Bldg, for permit to erect electric sign, granted.
Rev. W.F.Sharpe, for permit to erect tent Bowens Island, granted.

Commissioner Wright now placed in nomination the name of Thomas J. Martin for the position of Chief of Police of the City of San Antonio, and the nomination was confirmed by vote of the Commissioners.

Commissioner of Streets recommended that the contract for wiring Fire Station No. 2 to be constructed on East Crockett Street be awarded to Thompson Electric Company, and that the bid for plumbing and heating the building, submitted by A.H.Shafer be accepted.
Adopted.

The Commissioner of Streets recommended further that all bids for the general contract for construction of the Fire Station be rejected, and that the contract be awarded A.E.Rheiner & Co. on a basis of cost plus 10%, in no event is the amount to exceed their bid of \$29,600.00. The recommendation of the Commissioner of Streets was adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Black, Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Nay, Wright.

The recommendation of the City Engineer that the contract for paving Bakeview Avenue, from Main Avenue to Soledad Street, be awarded Uvalded Rock Asphalt Company, was adopted.

A resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into contract with Chas W.Scrubbs, et al for placing danger signals at street corners, was read and referred to City Attorney.
