Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered and approved.

WHEREAS, said improvements are generally described as follows, to-wit: The widening and straightening of said street between said points by setting back the property lines thereof, removing such improvements as exist between said lines, and acquiring such property as may be required for the purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has, in accordance with the improvement Ordinance, filed with the Commissioners his report, together with plans and specifications covering the proposed improvements, together with the statement of the cost of same, the names of the property owners abutting thereon, the description of the said property and the amount to be assessed against such owners and said property as their or its proportion of the cost of the making of such improvements, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE. That a public necessity exists for the widening and straightening of said East Nueva Street between the points aforementioned, and that the roll and report of the City Engineer, with the plans and other documents attached thereto are hereby approved and adopted and the new lines of said street are hereby designated as shown upon such plans and said improvements is hereby ordered made.

SECTION TWO: That in the opinion of the Commissioners it is necessary and proper to assess a part of the cost of said improvements against the owners of property abutting thereon and against their property, and it is so ordered.

SECTION THREE: That as appears from said roll and report as here now approved by the Commissioners, the total amount proposed to be assessed against the owners of abutting property is forty & No/100 (\$40.00) Dollars; that the amount per front foot to be assessed against such property owners on an average is estimated to be \$61,472.80 Dollars.

SECTION FOUR: That a hearing be given the owners of the said abutting property, and to all persons interested therein or having a lien thereon, their agents and attorneys, before the City Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, which hearing shall begin on the 9th day of May 1927, at 10:00 o'clock A.
