

AN ORDINANCE **2011-02-17-0139**

APPROVING “DISTRICT 2 SENIOR CENTER” AS THE NAME OF THE CITY'S DISTRICT 2 SENIOR MULTI-SERVICE CENTER LOCATED AT 1751 SOUTH W.W. WHITE ROAD IN SAN ANTONIO.

WHEREAS, in 2003, the City/County's Joint Commission on Elderly Affairs (the “Commission”) recommended establishing senior multi-service centers to better serve the senior citizens of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, the proposed facility in Council District 2 will be the fifth senior multi-purpose center established since the Commission's recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the District 2 Senior Multi-Service Center, located at 1751 South W.W. White Road, will offer a variety of direct social services, including congregate meals, computer classes, exercise, dance therapy, and health-related services, for seniors age 60 and older; and

WHEREAS, in coordination with the City Council District 2 office, “District 2 Senior Center”, was selected by staff as the proposed name for the District 2 Senior Multi-Service Center; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the City Code regulating the naming of City facilities, the proposed name was sent forward to the City Clerk and considered by the convened Naming Committee at a Public Hearing on February 8, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Naming Committee approved the proposed name and recommended the name be forwarded to the City Council for consideration and approval; and

WHEREAS, the Committee’s rationale for recommending the name is that it specifies the Council District location of the Center and is reflective of the purpose of the center which is to provide services to seniors in the area; and

WHEREAS, the Center is scheduled to open for service on Monday, March 14, 2011; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. City Council approves “District 2 Senior Center” as the name of the District 2 Senior Multi-Service Center, located at 1751 South W.W. White Road as recommended by the convened Naming Committee in accordance with the City’s Code regulating the naming of City facilities.

SECTION 2. City Council finds that the purpose for, and input required by, the City Code procedures for naming facilities has been satisfied. Therefore, the City-owned building at 1751 South W.W. White Road is hereby named District 2 Senior Center.

SECTION 3. There is no fiscal impact realized through the passage of this Ordinance.




