---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition of Davy Crockett Rifle Club for permit to establish a rifle range was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Petition of Bowser and Co. for modification of City ordinance regulating styles and sizes of gasoline storage tanks was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Petition of E.F. Gariel for correction of assessment was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

No. 199 *MC-581* AN ORDINANCE

Accepting proposal of _____ Sanchez for moving house on Devine Street for the purpose of opening street and authorizing contract and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO;

Section 1. (Acceptance) That the City does hereby accept the attached written proposal of said party named in the caption hereof to move house on Devine Street for the purpose of opening up Boerne Street in and for said City in accordance with the written specifications and description and drawings prepared and submitted by City Engineer provided said party making said proposal shall strictly comply with all requirements made by or under the provisions of this ordinance and all instruments herein referred to, which are made a part hereof.

Section 2. (Appropriation) That to defray the costs and expenses to be paid by the City by reason of the premises the sum of Two Hundred Dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be and the same is hereby appropriated out of ~~THE~~ The Street Opening and Widening Fund.

No. 200 *-582* AN ORDINANCE

Making appropriation to cover expense in connection with the acquisition of Lot 33, City Block 2958, for street purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street Widening Fund, to pay the cost of transferring a deed of trust lien in favor of Wimer, Richardson and Co. from Lot No. 33 in City Block 2958, to Lot No. 38 in the same block, in connection with the exchange of said Lot No. 38 for said Lot 33, acquired by the City of San Antonio for street purposes, and that warrant for said amount be drawn in favor of said Wimer, Richardson & Company.

Petition of Adolph Herff for correction of assessment was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.


