

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, JULY 17th, A.D.1922, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable O. B. Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition of citizens to have block on French Place macadamized was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets, etc.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police:
J.W.Howard, to erect building 421 Burnett Street.
Five Point Gas Filling Station to install tank and pump.
Central Auto Laundry, to install gasoline pump and tank.
Citizens on Jones Avenue, complaining of heavy traffic of reck wagons.
A.Guimbarda, for permit to erect two drive-in filling stations at S.Presa and Pereida Sts, and Garden and Pereida Sts.
Citizens, complaining of bill board at Garden and Nueva Streets.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks, etc.
Labor Day Committe, requesting use of San Pedro Park, Sept 3 and 4, 1922.
Warren E. Long, for refund of plumbing permit.

A Committee of Colored citizens presented a petition to the Commissioners requesting the City to pay balance due on Community House, located on Hackberry Street, and establish a public library for colored citizens. The matter was referred to the City Attorney for a report.

Commissioner Lambert made the following recommendations, which were adopted.
Petition of Everando to erect a hall at Cassiano Park, not granted.
Black & White Cab and Transfer Co. for permit to install telephone in Travis Park was granted, subject to revocation of the permit by the Commissioners at any time.

Appropriating money to pay for band concerts.
BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400) be hereby appropriated to defray the expenses of the band concerts held in Brackenridge Park from July 8 to 15th inc. To be charged to Zpo Fund.

Dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund, (Sewer Cons. Dep) for the payment to G.W.Storer, being the balance due on private sewer main in Burnett Street, between New Braunfels Ave and St. Johns Street. This is necessary account of paving this street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$646.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the River Improvement Fund 1919 to pay two weeks pay roll ending July 15, 1922.

No. 128 AN ORDINANCE
Appropriating \$31.03 to pay expense of trip to Houston by Commissioner of Taxation.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$31.03 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund Contingencies to pay expenses incurred by the Commissioner of Taxation on trip to Houston, Texas to attend meeting of the Auto Tax Division Committee.

Petition of R.H.Kersey, making proposition to City for the purchase of a certain lot, with opinion of City Attorney attached, was referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

The petition of citizens requesting the City to set aside a portion of Mahncke Park for school purposes, was again considered. An opinion by the City Attorney was read, and the matter laid over for further consideration.

Petition of Jno. W.Tobin for use of Alamo Plaza in front of Alamo Thursday, July 20, 1922, for the purpose of holding a public meeting was read and granted.

In reply to a request by A.D.Politis, that he be allowed the revenue obtained for renting of golf lockers at Brackenridge Park, the City Attorney recommended that the concession be granted Mr Politis in connection with his contract for all concessions in the park. Adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Black, Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

Bid of Peden Iron & Steel Co to supply City with Planing Mill was accepted. Bids for road grader were read, and recommendation of the City Purchasing Agent adopted. Bids for printing 30,000 circulars were opened and referred to City Purchasing Agent. Bid of H.C.S.Smith for 8 solid tire wheels for trucks were opened and referred to City Purchasing Agent.

Hearing of property owners interested in the improvement of Martinez Street, Burnett Street, Hackberry to Pine St, Cumberland Road, Grand Avenue, Pine Street, Commerce to Nolan, Lamar Street, Walnut to Pine St. was held. (For full particulars see Record of Hearings, pages 8, 10, 12, 13, 16 and 17)

No. 129 AN ORDINANCE
Transferring the sum of \$5200.00 from the 1922 Contingency Fund to the Street Opening & Widening Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:
SECTION ONE: That the sum of \$5200 be and the same is hereby transferred from the 1922 Contingency Fund to the Street Opening & Widening Fund.
SECTION TWO: The Auditor is hereby ordered and directed to draw the proper warrants or vouchers and to make the necessary entries upon the books of the City, showing the above transfer of said sum of money.
