

AN ORDINANCE **86118**

DESIGNATING CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL AS MAYOR PRO TEM FOR SPECIFIED PERIODS OF TIME THROUGH MAY 31, 1999.

WHEREAS, the City Charter in Section 9 calls for a Mayor Pro Tem to act as Mayor during the absence or disability of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, a tradition has been established of rotating the Mayor Pro Tem position among all of the members of the Council other than the Mayor during each two year term; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following named members of the City Council are hereby designated as Mayor Pro Tem of the City of San Antonio to serve during the periods indicated below:


