Following discussion, the Council, on motion of Commissioner Steffler, seconded by Commissioner Hein and carried by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler; Nay, Anderson (absent), ordered the petition denied, as recommended by the City Zoning Commission.

The commissioner added that there was money in the Flood Prevention Fund of 1924 which could be used to buy the property.




