**To deliberate the appointment, employment and evaluation of applicants for Municipal Court Judge positions**


The Quality of Life Council Committee met in executive session without any City Staff after conferring with the First Assistant City Attorney, Martha Sepeda, for a briefing.

Chairman Hall reconvened the meeting at 10:12 a.m.


**3. Discussion and possible action on recommendations for Municipal Court Judge positions**
