AN ORDINANCE

DEDICATING HILLTOP COURT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.

1. That the following described tract of land in Out Lot 27, Original City Block A-52, more particularly described as follows, be and the same is hereby dedicated as a public street and for purposes incidental thereto, that is:

2. BEGINNING at a point on the east property line of Dial Street, said point being 290.3 feet south of the south property line of East Hildebrand Avenue; THENCE in an easterly direction parallel to East Hildebrand Avenue, a distance of 932.3 feet to a point in the west property line of Devine Road; THENCE in a southerly direction along the west line of Devine Road, a distance of 55.6 feet to a point; THENCE in a westerly direction and parallel to East Hildebrand Avenue, a distance of 933.5 feet to a point in the east line of Dial Street; THENCE in a northerly direction along the east property line of Dial Street, a distance of 55.6 feet to the place of beginning, as per plat attached and on file in the City Engineer's Office, Case "H", No. 381.

3. Said street shall be known as Hilltop Court", and a plat thereof is hereto attached and made a part hereof for aid to the description.
