AN ORDINANCE 6285

ORDERING AN ELECTION TO DETERMINE WHETHER OR NOT HOUSE BILL 34 PASSED AT THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE FIFTIETH LEGISLATURE TO CREATE A FIREMEN'S AND POLICEMEN'S CIVIL SERVICE IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO BE ADOPTED: AND AN ELECTION TO AMEND THE CITY CHARTER OF SAN ANTONIO TO AUTHCRIZE THE ISSUE OF REVENUE BONDS TO FINANCE AUTOMOBILE PARKING STATIONS AND MARKET HOUSES AND MARKET PLACES: TO BE HELD ON THE 30TH DAY OF DECEMBER, A.D. 1947.

Before voting was called for on the above ordinance calling an election for the proposed Charter Amendment and the Fire and Police Civil Service Proposition, the Mayor asked if anyone in the Council Chamber would like to address the Commissioners.

Mr. C. W. Carroll arose and made a lengthy argument against submitting the Charter Amendment based principally upon its broadness and lack of limitations.

Then Mr. Edwin C. Sullivan representing certain Alamo Plaza merchants protested against the amendment, his principal objection being that the first parking facility would probably be near Houston Street or Travis Park, and thus Alamo Plaza would suffer.

Mayor Callaghan, after asking for additional remarks from citizens, then stated that he hoped everyone would vote for the \$6,000,000.00 Sanitary Sewer Bond Issue on December 9th, and also vote for the two propositions on December 30th.

His opinion was that San Antonio needed: 1st. Sewers, then Market Facilities and Parking Room. He asked that everyone forget politics for the next two years.

Commissioner South stated that he wanted to submit the questions to the voters, but that this did not necessarily mean he would support them.

A vote was then taken on the ordinance which was unanimous in favor of its passage.


