

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 15TH, A.D. 1919.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Heuermann and Wright. Absent, Lambert.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition for the paving of Nolan Street, from Pine Street to New Braunfels Avenue was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

Commissioner Heuermann introduced a resolution ordering a public hearing of property owners and others interested in street improvements ordered to be constructed on Travis & Frion- River Avenue, Ashby Place, Ruiz Street, New Braunfels Avenue, Locust St. Woodlawn Ave. Kentucky Ave. and Calaveras. Pine & Sherman. Piedmont, Burleson, approving plat and statement of City Engineer and ordering special assessments to be made and levied, and for other purposes.

Commissioner Coy made the following recommendations which were adopted:

Flores Street Baptist Church, for correction of assessment, granted.

Mackey Telegraph & Cable Company, for reduction of assessment granted, and that said Company be allowed to pay on a valuation of \$8000 (franchise) for years 1914 to 1918 inclusive.

AN ORDINANCE *MD-67*

Appropriating \$2512.75 out of 1919 General Fund to pay sundry merchants bills.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Twenty five hundred, twelve and 75/100 dollars, (\$2512.75) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is, hereby appropriated out of the 19 19 General Fund to pay sundry merchants bills per itemized invoices in office of City Auditor.

AN ORDINANCE *-69*

Refunding the sum of Fifty Dollars (50.00) received from the Clerk of the Corporation Court on the forfeiture of the bond of Tom Cunningham in cause No. 3428 in said court and making appropriation therefor.

WHEREAS, in Cause No, 3428, styled " The State of Texas vs Tom Cunningham," in the Corporation Court in the City of San Antonio, Texas, the cash bond of said defendant Tom Cunningham was on the 5th day of September 1919 declared forfeited and thereafter to-wit:, on the 5th day of September, 1919, said sum of Fifty Dollars (50.00) was paid over to the Collector of the City of San Antonio by the Clerk of said Court as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, thereafter, to-wit, on the 12th day of September, 1919, a rehearing was granted in the said cause and the forfeiture of said bond set aside

and said cause set down for trial, together with another case against said defendant ,
to-wit, Cause No. 3429, styled "The State of Texas vs Tom Cunningham" on the records of
said Court; and

WHEREAS, the said defendant was filed in the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00)
in each of said cases and in compliance with the order of said court it becomes necessary
to refund the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) received in the forfeiture of said bond,

THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) be and the same
is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund, warrant for which shall be drawn in
favor of Tom Cunningham, as a refund of the amount of money received by the Collector
of the City of San Antonio from the Clerk of the Corporation Court on the forfeiture of
the bond of said Tom Cunningham in Cause No 3428, styled "The State of Texas vs. Tom
Cunningham," in the Corporation Court in the City of San Antonio, Texas, and that said
warrant shall be turned over the Clerk of said Corporation Court and by him delivered to
said Tom Cunningham, upon the payment of fines aggregating Ten Dollars (\$10.00) assessed
agaibst defendant in cases Nos. 3428 and 3429 in said court.

AN ORDINANCE *-72*

Appropriating money for the City Clerks Incidental Fund.

\$90.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to transfer to the
City Clerks Incidental Expenditures Fund, to cover fines remitted by order of the Mayor
and paid out of said Incidental Expenditures Fund, to and including Sept 15, 1919.
