

AN ORDINANCE      2008-10-02-0879

**AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS FROM THE SAN ANTONIO CONSERVATION SOCIETY TO EMPLOY INTERNS TO INPUT THE 36-SQUARE MILE HISTORIC SURVEY DATA INTO THE CITY'S DATABASE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Antonio is currently in the process of identifying buildings, objects, sites, or structures designated historic landmarks, located within a historic district, or that may have historical, cultural, architectural, or archaeological significance in the City of San Antonio; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio Conservation Society provided grant funding for a total amount of \$50,000.00 beginning in 2001 to the city of San Antonio, through the Ann Eichenroht Miller bequest, for the architectural survey of the original 36-square mile area of San Antonio; and

**WHEREAS**, acceptance of a grant in an amount of \$13,604.96 will complete the entire \$50,000.00 originally pledged by the San Antonio Conservation Society for this survey; and

**WHEREAS**, the information collected and entered in the city's database will be made available to the public; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept an additional \$13,604.96 from the San Antonio Conservation Society, to be used to employ interns to begin inputting the 36-square mile Historic Survey data into the City's database.

**SECTION 2.** Fund 2601250001 entitled "Intern Prog 36-Sq Mile Survey Orig City" and Internal Order 150000000021, are hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant.


**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall become effective on October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

Ordinance to accept grant funds from the San Antonio Conservation Society

**SUMMARY:**

This ordinance accepts grant funds in the amount of \$13,604.96 from the San Antonio Conservation Society (SACS). These funds will be used to employ interns to begin inputting the 36-square mile Historic Survey data into the City's database. Upon completion of the Historic Survey, information identified will be made available to the public through the City's website.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The San Antonio Conservation Society provided grant funding for a total amount of \$50,000.00 beginning in 2001, through the Ann Eichenroht Miller bequest, for the architectural survey of the original 36-square mile area of San Antonio. The survey area covers the original city limits as defined in 1856. From 2001 to 2005, SACS provided computer laptops, materials and paid interns to assist with the project. In September 2005, SACS provided \$15,000.00 of the original grant amount of \$50,000.00 to the City to fund internships in the Planning Department for work on the original 36 square mile survey.

**ISSUE:**

This is a continuation of a previous grant provided by the San Antonio Conservation Society to the City of San Antonio for the 36 square mile survey. Acceptance of the grant amount of \$13,604.96 will complete the entire \$50,000.00 originally pledged by the San Antonio Conservation Society for this project. This funding will make the 36-square mile Historic Survey data available to the public through the City of San Antonio website.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

Should grant funds not be accepted, this information will not be as readily available to the public.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This grant is for the FY 2009 and is in an amount not to exceed \$13,604.96. The grant provides expenses for interns to enter the 36-square mile Historic Survey data into the City's database. This information will eventually be made available to the public through the City's website.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval of the acceptance of the grant from the San Antonio Conservation Society for the 36 square mile historic survey.
