

AN ORDINANCE **85933**

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 85569 OF FEBRUARY 6, 1997, WHICH ADOPTED POLLING LOCATIONS FOR THE MAY 3, 1997, JOINT AND CHARTER REVISION ELECTION, TO PROVIDE POLLING PLACES FOR SPLIT PRECINCTS 1057, 4121, AND 1082; AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE UPON THE PASSAGE OF EIGHT (8) AFFIRMATIVE VOTES.

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WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 85569 of February 6, 1997, adopted polling locations for the May 3, 1997, Joint and Charter Revision Election; and

WHEREAS, the Voter Registration Office of Bexar County has advised the City Clerk of new voter registrations in some of the split precincts which necessitates the securing of polling places for these precincts; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend Ordinance No. 85569 to provide for polling places for split precincts 1057, 4121, and 1082; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 85569 passed and approved on February 6, 1997, is hereby amended so as to provide for polling places for Precinct 1057 (District 3), Precinct 4121 (District 3) and Precinct 1082 (District 4) as follows:


Precinct 1057, District 3 (5 voters), Father Roman Recreation Center, 11030 Ruidosa, in Precinct 1055 as the voting site.

Precinct 4121, District 3 (15 voters) Rogers Middle School, 314 Galway, in Precinct 4023 as the voting site.


Precinct 1082, District 4 (2 voters) Adams Hills Elementary, 9627 Adams Hill, in Precinct 1071 as the voting site.


SECTION 2. Because the Joint and Charter Revision Election is scheduled for May 3, 1997, and the amendments made herein must take effect before then in furtherance of the public welfare, an emergency is hereby declared so that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage by eight (8) affirmative votes; otherwise this ordinance shall take effect on the tenth day after passage hereof.

SUMMARY:

This ordinance amends Ordinance No. 85569 of February 6, 1997, which adopted polling locations for the May 3, 1997 Joint and Charter Revision Election.

BACKGROUND:

The Voter Registration Office of Bexar County has advised us of new voter registrations in some of our split precincts which necessitates the securing of polling places for these precincts.

District: 3, Precinct 1057 (5 voters) we will be using the Father Roman Recreation Center, 11030 Ruidosa, in Precinct 1055 as the voting site.

District: 3, Precinct 4121 (15 voters) we will be using Rogers Middle School, 314 Galway, in Precinct 4023 as the voting site.

District: 4, Precinct 1082 (2 voters) we will be using Adams Hills Elementary, 9627 Adams Hill, in Precinct 1074 as the voting site.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:


No extra costs to the Elections Budget due to the combining of these split precincts with existing polling sites.

POLICY IMPLICATIONS:


This ordinance is in keeping with existing policy of providing a polling site for all precincts if there are registered voters within that precinct.
