PRESENT: Honorable John W. Tobin, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Steffler, Wright, Absent Lambert.

Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The following petition was read and referred to the Commissioner of Streets etc.
Petition of the City of Alamo Heights and suburbs known as Terrell Hills, and Blue Bonnet Hills, for the right to connect with the Sanitary Sewer System of the City of San Antonio.

City Purchasing Agent recommended acceptance of the following proposals, to-wit -
San Antonio Sewer Pipe for sewer pipe required during next six months.
Grayburg Co. for gasoline required for six months.
San Antonio Portland Cement Co. for cement required for next six months.
Oriental Oil Co. for lubricating oil and grease requirements for next six months.

Accepting the paving on Ruiz Street between Laredo and Trinity by the Southwest Bitulithic Company.




