AN ORDINANCE *MD-408*

Appropriating \$301.18 to pay Uvalde Rock Asphalt Company.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$301.18 be and is hereby appropriated out of the Opening, Widening and Straightening Streets Fund to pay the account of the Uvalde Rock Asphalt Company for paving done on Romana Street in front of 50 feet of Lot 14, N.C.B.180, formerly owned by Miss A.M. Sullivan and by her dedicated to the City for Public Purposes.

AN ORDINANCE *-409*

Appropriating \$39.54 to pay B. Cochran for a strip of land.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$39.54 be and is hereby appropriated out of the Opening, Widening and Straightening Streets Fund to pay B. Cochran for a strip of land 18 feet in length and 13 feet in width now encroaching upon the South side of Potomac Street.

AN ORDINANCE *-410*

Appropriating sundry sums of money out of various funds to pay merchants bills.

AN ORDINANCE

Prohibiting the sale, throwing or use on any street, alley, park, public ground or other public place in the City of San Antonio during any festival, carnival, fiesta or other public gathering, celebration or demonstration, of any confetti, feather dusters, wife beaters, paint, shoe polish, talcum powder, flour, meal, whips, flap jacks, ticklers, torpedoes ~~or explosives~~ or explosives of any sort.

RESOLUTION.


Announcing Health Week beginning April 19th, and ending April 24th.


