AN ORDINANCE *MD-362*

Appropriating \$7500.00 to pay for property for the widening of Losoya Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$7500.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the Opening, Widening and Straightening Streets Fund to pay for property to be purchased from Mrs Della Bishop, required for the widening and straightening of Losoya Street at the S.E. corner of Crockett and Losoya Streets, in accordance with field notes to be furnished by the City Engineer.

Commissioner Heuermann introduced the following resolution, which was read and adopted.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to advertize for topping the Frio City Road, Brazos Street, with a bituminous surface, from Laredo Street to City limits, in accordance with specifications to be seen in the office of the City Engineer, all bids to be received until 4 o'clock p.m. on March 25, 1920.

AN ORDINANCE *-362.1*

Appropriating \$25,500 to pay regular merchants bills for February, 1920.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Twenty Five Thousand, five hundred dollars, (\$25,500.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay Merchants bills for the month of February, 1920 for the following departments:

AN ORDINANCE MD-365

Appropriating money to defray the expense of grubbing out and delivering Spanish Dagger Plants to Brackenridge Park received from Theodore Steubing.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Forty Five (\$45.00) Dollars be and is hereby appropriated to defray the expense of grubbing out and delivering to Brackenridge Park a certain amount (25) of spanish dagger plants to be used in the various parks, same being received from the ranch of Theodore Steubing, situated on the North Loop.


AN ORDINANCE -366

Appropriating money to pay for a certain amount of spanish dagger plants received from the ranch of Theodore Steubing.


