

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, DECEMBER 15TH, A.D.1921, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Jno. P. Pfeiffer, Mayor Pro-tem, presiding, and Commissioners Lambert, Rieden, Wright. Absent, Mayor Black.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police:

Written charges against J.B.Swift, Jitney Inspector of the City, filed by Thomas J. Martin, Chief of Police, were read, and a hearing of same was fixed for Thursday, December 22, 1921, at 2 P.M.

An invitation from the Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen and Enginemen to attend a lecture at Market Hall Saturday, Dec. 17th, was read and accepted.

Petition of property owners on Schley Avenue requesting that a gas main be laid on this street, was read and referred to City Attorney.

Petition for the closing of an alley in C.B.2982, together with the opinion of the City Attorney thereon in which he recommended that it be granted, was, after some discussion referred to the City Engineer for further investigation.

Petition of Sunrise System for permit to erect racks for mail boxes near City limits, was refused on motion of Commissioner Wright, duly seconded and carried.

Bids for furnishing cement to the City were opened and referred to City Purchasing Agent.

Bids for paving Dallas Street were opened and read and referred to City Engineer for tabulation.

The hearing of the property owners on Labor Street paving, set for this date, was postponed until Monday, December 19th.

AN ORDINANCE
