

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1257 PASSED AND APPROVED 3 DAY OF AUGUST, 1944, TO CORRECT A PORTION OF SAID ORDINANCE AND MORE DEFINITELY FIX THE LOCATION OF A PORTION OF THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO SO DESCRIBED.

* * *

1. WHEREAS, an ordinance by the City Council dated August 3, 1944, being Ordinance No. 1257 and recorded in Ordinance Book M, page 11, described a portion of the northeast city limits line of Olmos Park as follows:
2. "West along the north city limits line of the City of San Antonio to its intersection with the east line of Olmos Park; northwesterly along the northeast city limits line of Olmos Park to the point of beginning of the land described herein"; and,
3. WHEREAS the beginning point of the said boundary and limits of the City of San Antonio described in the said ordinance is located "where the northwest line of West Side Drive intersects the south line of Contour Drive, the same being the common point with the northwest corner of the city limits of Olmos Park", and
4. WHEREAS, the intersection of the north line of the City of San Antonio with the east line of Olmos Park, being the second from the last call in the field notes of the bounds and limits of the City of San Antonio set forth in said ordinance is in fact the point which is the southeast corner of Lot 9 of Encino Estates subdivision which is also the southeast corner of the bounds and limits of the City of Olmos Park, and
5. WHEREAS, the northeast city limits line of Olmos Park between its southeast corner and east line of Devine Road is the same as the west or northwesterly line of city park property of the City of San Antonio and is also in part the common boundary of the City of Olmos Park, the City of San Antonio and a certain 4.195 acre tract deeded to H. C. Thorman by Sisters of Charity of Incarnate Word dated January 18, 1928, and recorded in Vol. 1002, page 273 Deed Records of Bexar County, Texas, and being the same property described in its subdivision plat dated June 6, 1934, and recorded in Vol. 1635, page 343 Deed and Plat Records of Bexar County, Texas; and,
6. WHEREAS the description of the northeast boundary of the town of Olmos Park was corrected by an order of the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas, dated August 2, 1950, being No. 179,139 and effective as of May 25, 1939, to which reference is made in order to clarify said description; and,
7. WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio desires to correct that portion of the description of its said boundary as contained in the aforesaid Ordinance No. 1257 in order to fix more definitely the location of said portion of its said boundary; NOW, THEREFORE:-

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

8. That the following portion of Paragraph 2 of said Ordinance No. 1257 which reads as follows:

"THENCE West along the north city limits line of the City of San Antonio to its intersection with the east line of Olmos Park; THENCE northwesterly along the northeast city limits line of Olmos Park to the point of beginning of the land described herein"

be and the same is hereby stricken and that there shall be substituted therefor the following, so that said ordinance shall hereafter read as follows, to-wit:


THENCE west along the north city limits line of the City of San Antonio to its intersection with the east line of Olmos Park, said point of intersection being the southeast corner of the City of Olmos Park and of Lot 9, Encino Estates Subdivision; THENCE northwesterly along the east or northeast line of Olmos Park to the northwest line of Olmos Drive and the southeast line of the 4.195 acre tract of land above referred to; THENCE northeast along the northwest line of Olmos Drive to the easternmost corner of the said 4.195 acre tract of land, the same being in the southwest line of City park property of the City of San Antonio; THENCE northwesterly along the northeast boundary line of the city of Olmos Park and the southwest boundary line of city park property of the City of San Antonio, (the same being the northeast boundary line of said 4.195 acre tract above referred to), to its intersection with the east line of Devine Road; THENCE north along the east line of Devine Road and the west line of city park property of the City of San Antonio to a point in the east line of Devine Road, the intersection of the north line of Park Drive extended with the east line of Devine Road; THENCE northwesterly along the northeast city limits line of Olmos Park to the point of beginning of the land described herein.

9. That the City Engineer shall cause the records of his office to conform to the last hereinabove contained description of the bounds and limits of the City of San Antonio as fixed by this ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1257 PASSED AND APPROVED 3 DAY OF AUGUST, 1944, TO CORRECT A PORTION OF SAID ORDINANCE AND MORE DEFINITELY FIX THE LOCATION OF PORTION OF THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO SO DESCRIBED", BEING NO. 13,900 PASSED AND APPROVED 18 JANUARY, 1951, BY AMENDING SECTION 9 THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That Section 9 of an ordinance, being No. 13,900, passed and approved 18 January, 1951, entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE NO. 1257 PASSED AND APPROVED 3 DAY OF AUGUST, 1944, TO CORRECT A PORTION OF SAID ORDINANCE AND MORE DEFINITELY FIX THE LOCATION OF A PORTION OF THE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO SO DESCRIBED", be and the same is amended hereby so that the same shall hereafter read as follows:

"That the City Engineer shall cause the records of his office to conform to the last hereinabove contained description of the bounds and limits of the City of San Antonio as fixed by this ordinance, and any assessment of said 4.195 acre tract, or any part thereof, by the City of San Antonio for the year 1950, or any previous year, is hereby declared void and is hereby cancelled, and the Department of Taxation shall correct its records accordingly by removing same from the tax rolls for 1950 and all previous years."

2. Otherwise said ordinance shall remain and be in full force and effect as passed and approved.

3. PASSED AND APPROVED this 15th day of February, A. D. 1951.

On this the 2nd. day of August, 1950 came on to be considered the petition of the Town of Olmos Park filed herein on the 2nd day of August, 1950, wherein said town seeks to amend and correct an order and attached plat entered by this Court on the 25th. day of May, 1939, in No. 179139, which canvassed the returns of election, set forth the limits and boundaries of said town, declared said town to be incorporated, and ordered an election to select a town council, and the Court having considered said petition and having heard evidence thereon and being of the opinion that the aforesaid order and plat should be corrected and amended in accordance with said petition so that the boundaries and limits of the town of Olmos Park shall include the 4.195-acre tract described in said petition and so that the plat thereof shall show that said tract is included within the boundaries and limits of said town;

It is therefore ordered that the following limits and boundaries shall be and constitute the Town of Olmos Park, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the line which marks the North line and city limits of the City of San Antonio, and at a point which is 150 feet west of the west line of McCullough Avenue, for the southwest corner of the town of Olmos Park; Thence North and running parallel to the west line of McCullough Avenue to a point on the east line of the Missouri Pacific Railway right-of-way which point is 150 feet from the west line of McCullough Avenue; Thence in a northeasterly direction along the eastern line of the Missouri Pacific Railway right-of-way and continuing with the northwest line of West Side Drive to a point where the northwest line of West Side Drive and the east line of the Missouri Pacific Railway right-of-way intersects with the north line of Contour Drive; Thence from the intersection of the northwest line of West Side Drive and the north line of Contour Drive east with the said north line of Contour Drive to where said north line of Contour Drive turns south and continuing with said line which is now the eastern line of Contour Drive to the point where that line intersects the North line of Olmos Drive which point is the northeast intersection of Contour Drive and Olmos Drive; Thence East with the North line of Olmos Drive to the point where the North line of Park Drive intersects with the North line of Olmos Drive; Thence north and east with the north line of Park Drive to the point where that line intersects the Western line of Devine Road and at a point on the Western line of the Park Property belonging to the City of San Antonio; Thence South along the East line of Devine Road and the West line of City Park Property mentioned above to the Northwest corner of that tract containing 4.195 acres, deeded to H. C. Thorman by the Sisters of Charity of Incarnate Word, a corporation, by deed dated January 18, 1928, and recorded in Vol. 1002, p. 273, Deed Records of Bexar County, Texas; Thence in a Southerly direction along the Westerly line of the City Park Property belonging to the City of San Antonio, and the Easterly line of the above mentioned 4.195 acre tract to the intersection of that line, and the Northwest line of Olmos Drive; Thence Southwesterly along the Northwest line of Olmos Drive to a point which is a continuation of the line which is the northeast boundary line of the Division known as


the Encino Estates; Thence Southeast across Olmos Drive and with the Northeast line of the said Encino Estates to a point where that line intersects the East line of the Encino Estates; Thence South with the East line of the Encino Estates and the West line of the park property of the City of San Antonio, to the point where said East line of the Encino Estates intersects the North line of the City Limits of San Antonio; Thence West along the North line of the City Limits of the City of San Antonio to the place of beginning, which point is 150 west of the west line of McCullough Avenue and on the North line of the City Limits of San Antonio, said territory being located in Bexar County, Texas.

It is further ordered that the foregoing limits and boundaries shall take the place of and be in lieu of the limits and boundaries described in the aforesaid order of May 25, 1939, and that this order shall be effective as of May 25, 1939.

It is further ordered that the attached plat reflecting the correction of the area and limits of said town shall be and become a part of this order and shall take the place and be in lieu of the plat attached to said order of May 25, 1939, and that the limits and boundaries of said town shall be in accordance with the foregoing calls, metes and bounds and in accordance with the attached plat which is made a part hereof.

It is further ordered that said original order of May 25, 1939, in all other respects shall be and remain as written.

It is further ordered that this order be entered upon the records of the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas, and that a certified copy of this order, together with the plat attached hereto, be recorded in the Deed Records of Bexar County, Texas.

Gentlemen:

1. The undersigned petitioner is the owner of property located between the East side of Devine Road and the West line of City Park Property abutting on Olmos Drive and purporting to be in the Town of Olmos Park.

4. That the vagueness in the description of the boundary of the City of San Antonio has caused uncertainty as to its location and much inconvenience to Petitioner and should be clarified.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that same be corrected by your Honorable Council.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS:

Now comes the Town of Olmos Park, situated in Bexar County, Texas, and incorporated under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Texas, acting by and through its duly authorized officials and petitions your Honorable Court to enter an order to clarify the boundaries and limits and correcting and amending the plat of said town now on file attached to and made a part of the Order of this Court under File No. 179139, dated May 25, 1939; said order and said plat being of record in Vol. 1693, pp. 603-607, of the Deed Records of Bexar County, Texas.

Petitioner shows that the aforesaid plat does not correspond to the actual and correct boundaries and limits of said town described in the order of said Commissioners' Court above referred to, wherein said Court canvassed the returns of an election and declaring the incorporation of said town in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas.

The boundaries and limits of said Town of Olmos Park as described in said order particularly designating the west line of City Park property and definitely including therein a certain tract of land containing 4.195 acres of land and being bounded on the West by Devine Road and on the South by Olmos Drive and Dam and on the North and East by property owned by the City of San Antonio and designated as City Park Property and being the same property described in that certain deed from Sisters of Charity of Incarnate Word, a corporation, to H. C. Thorman, dated January 18, 1928, and recorded in Vol. 1002, p. 273, Deed Records, Bexar County, Texas, and being also the same property described in a Subdivision Plat recorded in Vol. 1625, p. 343, Deed and Plat Records, Bexar County, Texas, to which reference is here made.

Petitioner avers that the boundaries shown on the plat attached to the aforesaid Commissioners' Court Order omits and fails to include the above described 4.195 acres of land within the corporate limits of the Town of Olmos Park. That said plat is erroneous and does not truly and correctly reflect the limits and boundaries of said Town of Olmos

Park and Petitioner requests that this Honorable Court enter its order amending and correcting the discrepancy disclosed and that it direct and order the filing of an amended and corrected plat to be filed in the Deed Records of said County.

In order to clarify a certain portion of the boundaries and limits of the Town of Olmos Park, the following is submitted as a true and correct description of the boundaries and limits thereof, along with a corrected plat herewith attached, as follows:

Beginning at a point on the line which marks the North line and city limits of the City of San Antonio, and at a point which is 150 feet west of the west line of McCullough Avenue, for the southwest corner of the town of Olmos Park; Thence North and running parallel to the west line of McCullough Avenue to a point on the east line of the Missouri Pacific Railway right-of-way which point is 150 feet from the west line of McCullough Avenue; Thence in a northeasterly direction along the eastern line of the Missouri Pacific Railway right-of-way and continuing with the northwest line of West Side Drive to a point where the northwest line of west side drive and the east line of the Missouri Pacific Railway right-of-way intersects with the north line of Contour Drive; Thence from the intersection of the northwest line of West Side Drive and the north line of Contour Drive east with the said north line of Contour Drive to where said north line of Contour Drive turns south and continuing with said line which is now the eastern line of Contour Drive to the point where that line intersects the North line of Olmos Drive which point is the northeast intersection of Contour Drive and Olmos Drive; Thence East with the North line of Olmos Drive to the point where the North line of Park Drive intersects with the North line of Olmos Drive; Thence north and east with the north line of Park Drive to the point where that line intersects the eastern line of Devine Road and at a point on the Western line of the Park Property belonging to the City of San Antonio; Thence South along the East line of Devine Road and the West line of City Park Property mentioned above to the Northwest corner of that tract containing 4.195 acres, deeded to H. C. Thorman by the Sisters of Charity of Incarnate Word, a corporation, by deed dated January 18, 1928, and recorded in Vol. 1002, p. 273, Deed Records of Bexar County, Texas; Thence in a Southerly direction along the Westerly line of the City Park Property belonging to the City of San Antonio, and the Easterly line of the above mentioned 4.195 acre tract to the intersection of that line, and the Northwest line of Olmos Drive; Thence Southwesterly along the Northwest line of Olmos Drive to a point which is a continuation of the line which is the northeast boundary line of the Division known as the Encino Estates; Thence Southeast across Olmos Drive and with the Northeast line of the said Encino Estates to a point where that line intersects the East line of the Encino Estates; Thence South with the east line of the Encino Estates and the West line of the park property of the City of San Antonio, to the point where said East line of the Encino Estates intersects the North line of the City Limits of San Antonio; Thence West along the North line of the City Limits of the City of San Antonio to the place of beginning, which point is 150 feet west of the west line of McCullough Avenue and on the North line of the City Limits of San Antonio, said territory being located in Bexar County, Texas.





west along the north line of the City limits of the City of San Antonio to the place of beginning which point is 150 feet west of the west line of McCullough Avenue and on the north line of the City limits of San Antonio, said territory being located in Bexar County, Texas. x7

It is further ordered that an election be held on Thursday, the 8th day of June 1939, at the office of H.C. Thorman, in the 100 Block of El Prado Drive, located within the corporate limits of the town of Olmos Park, for the purpose of electing the following officers of the town of Olmos Park, a Mayor, a Marshal, and five (5) Aldermen and that such election be held in the manner prescribed for holding such elections in other cases.

It is further ordered that Gordon Friedrich, who is a resident of the town of Olmos Park, and is a duly qualified elector under the laws of the State of Texas be and he is hereby appointed as the Presiding Judge and Officer to preside at such election, and the said Gordon Friedrich is hereby authorized to elect 2 judges and 2 clerks to assist him in the holding of such election.

It is further ordered that notice of such election shall be given by posting advertisement thereof at 3 public places within the corporate limits of the Town of Olmos Park for ten days prior to the date of the holding of such election.

It is further ordered that this order be entered upon the records of the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County, Texas, and that a certified copy of this order, together with the plat attached hereto be recorded in the deed records of Bexar County, Texas.
