

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO HELD IN  
THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, ON  
WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 6, 1967 AT 9:30 A.M.

Pursuant to the call by the Mayor of the Special Meeting, the Council Meeting convened with the following Members present: CALDERON, JONES, JAMES, COCKRELL, TREVINO, PARKER, TORRES; (McALLISTER and GATTI arrived late).

Councilman Gerald Parker was designated to preside over the meeting.

The invocation was given by Councilman S. H. James.

67-661 The Council then proceed to make the official canvass of the returns of the December 5, 1967 Special Election on the question of adoption of a one percent (1%) City Sales and Use Tax within the City.

Mayor Pro-Tem Gatti arrived and presided over the meeting.

After the canvass of the returns was completed, the Clerk read the following ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE 35,980

CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING THE  
RESULT OF AN ELECTION HELD ON  
DECEMBER 5, 1967, ON THE QUESTION OF  
ADOPTION OF A ONE PERCENT (1%) LOCAL  
SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the 60th Texas Legislature enacted House Bill 207, the Local Sales and Use Tax Act (Article 1066c), authorizing incorporated cities, towns and villages by majority vote of the qualified voters to impose a local sales and use tax of one percent (1%); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Act, Ordinance No. 35866 was enacted October 26, 1967, ordering an election be held on December 5, 1967; on the question of adoption of the 1% Local Sales and Use Tax within the City; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly and legally held on the 5th day of December, 1967, in conformity with law and the aforementioned ordinance, and the results of said election have been certified and returned to the City Council by the proper officials; and

WHEREAS, this Council has this day considered the returns of said election on said question; and

WHEREAS, said election was in all respects lawfully held and said returns duly and legally made; NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council, having canvassed the returns of the Special Election held December 5, 1967, declares the result of the election to be as follows:

"FOR adoption of a one percent (1%)  
Local Sales and Use Tax within the  
City" 35,906 votes

"AGAINST adoption of a one percent  
(1%) Local Sales and Use Tax within  
the City" 16,962 votes

and, therefore, the proposition was approved by 18,944 votes.

SECTION 2. A majority of the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio having voted for adoption of a one percent (1%) Local Sales and Use Tax within the City, it is, therefore, declared adopted in the City of San Antonio pursuant to the Local Sales and Use Tax Act (Article 1066c, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes).

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is directed to forward to the State Comptroller, by United States certified or registered mail, a certified copy of this ordinance together with the required map of the City, pursuant to Section 2 (I) of said Act.

## AN ORDINANCE 35,981

APPOINTING GERALD C. HENCKEL, JR. AS  
THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF SAN  
ANTONIO, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 6, 1967  
AND FIXING THE ANNUAL SALARY AND  
ANNUAL EXPENSE FUNDS TO BE PAID TO  
SAID CITY MANAGER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Article V,  
Section 45 of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, Gerald C.  
Henckel, Jr. is hereby appointed as the City Manager of the City  
of San Antonio, effective December 6, 1967.

2. Pursuant to the provisions of Article V,  
Section 45 of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, the annual  
salary of the City Manager of the City of San Antonio is hereby  
fixed at \$25,000.00 per year, effective December 6, 1967. Said  
salary shall be paid to said City Manager in semi-monthly payments,  
each of which shall be, as nearly as practicable, equal to one  
twenty-fourth (1/24) of said annual salary.

3. The City Manager of the City of San Antonio is  
hereby allocated for expenses other than travel expenses to be in-  
curred in the conduct of his official duties, an annual amount of  
\$2,400.00, effective December 6, 1967. Said annual expense funds  
shall be paid to the City Manager in semi-monthly payments, each  
of which shall be as nearly as practicable, equal to one twenty-  
fourth (1/24) of the annual amount.
