

AN ORDINANCE **97603**

**DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE
REGULAR AND JOINT ELECTION HELD ON MAY 3, 2003;
ORDERING A RUN-OFF ELECTION FOR THE CITY
COUNCIL TO BE HELD ON MAY 27, 2003; AND
ESTABLISHING EARLY VOTING AND ELECTION DAY
POLLING LOCATIONS FOR THE RUN-OFF ELECTION.**

WHEREAS, the Regular and Joint Election was held on the 3rd day of May, 2003, to determine the Mayor and Council Members of the City of San Antonio for ensuing terms of office of two years; and

WHEREAS, the names of the candidates were submitted, the election was held and conducted and the returns thereof were made, all as required by the City Charter and the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Canvassing Authority Committee met on May 6, 2003, to canvass the returns of said election, and it is now necessary to declare the official results of the canvass; and

WHEREAS, at said election, no candidate for the Office of Council Member for Places 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 8 received a majority of all the votes for the office sought, cast by the qualified voters voting in said election, and therefore, no candidate was elected at said election for the Office of Council Member for Places 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 8; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to order a Run-off Municipal Election for May 27, 2003, for the purpose of electing the Council Members for those districts; and

WHEREAS, it is further necessary to establish early voting sites and Election Day polling sites for the Run-off Election, and to take other actions related to the May 3, 2003 Election and the May 27, 2003 Run-off Election;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council's Canvassing Authority Committee having convened on May 6, 2003, to canvass the returns of the Regular and Joint Election held on May 3, 2003, and after canvassing the returns of said election, does hereby find and declare the results of the election to be as follows

and each of them were elected by receiving a majority of all the votes cast for the office for which each was a candidate cast by the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio voting at said election, and each of them are hereby declared to be the lawful and duly elected Council Member of the City of San Antonio for the places specified.


SECTION 3. It is further declared that as a result of said election, no candidate for Places 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 8 received a majority of all votes cast by the qualified voters of the City voting in said election, as required by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, and therefore, no candidate was elected for Member of Council for these places. A Run-off election will be necessary in order that the candidate receiving the highest number of votes shall have received a majority of all the votes cast for the office. The two candidates in each of the Places 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 8 receiving the highest number of votes for each such place in the May 3rd Election shall again be voted for at the May 27th Run-off Election.

SECTION 4. A Run-off Election for the purpose of electing members of the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Places 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 8 is hereby ordered to be held in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas on the 27th day of May, 2003, in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio. The official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes for each of the Places 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 8 shall again be voted for at the Run-off Election ordered herein.



FINANCIAL IMPACT


The financial impact to the Elections Budget will be substantially less, and will be based on the number of districts in the run-off election. The estimated cost to the City of San Antonio for the run-off election will be approximately \$180,000.00.

POLICY ANALYSIS

In accordance with Section 4 of the City Charter, a run-off election is required when none of the candidates in a particular race garners a majority of the votes cast.
