

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

AFTER ADJOURNMENT OF MONDAY, OCTOBER 29TH, A.D.1917

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 31ST, A.D.1917, 11 A.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Lambert, Heuermann and Lowther.

At this regular meeting of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio came on to be considered the returns of a special election for Commissioner of Taxation held on the 30th day of October 1917, and the Mayor having appointed a Committee consisting of all of the Commissioners with the Mayor as Chairman, to canvass the returns of said election and report thereon, and said Committee having canvassed said returns and having made the following report, to-wit:


