September 26, 1939.

Gentlemen:

A plan of reorganization has been submitted to us by the Chief of Police and the Fire and Police Commissioner. We recommend that this plan be adopted by the City Commission.

We find that there is a need for changes in the Civil Service Code. Pending reorganization, we suggest repeal of Sections 38 to 43 inclusive of the present Code.

In making these recommendations, we realize that the best interests of the City will be served by reorganization of the Police Department. We believe if this reorganization is effected and approved by the City Commission and the citizens of San Antonio, that we may eventually have one of the finest police forces in America.
