

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO HELD IN  
THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL  
ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 13, 1962 AT 8:30 A.M.

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The regular meeting of the City Council was called to order by the Presiding Officer, Mayor Walter W. McAllister, with the following members present: McALLISTER, DE LA GARZA, KAUFMAN, GATTI, PADILLA, PARKER, BREMER and GUNSTREAM; ABSENT: ROHLFS.
