

AN ORDINANCE **72269**

AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE CITY CODE TO PROVIDE FOR ALL FOOD RELATED LICENSES AND PERMITS ISSUED BY THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO EXPIRE ONE (1) YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE AND ALLOWING THE DIRECTOR OF HEALTH TO PHASE IN LICENSE RENEWALS IN ORDER TO STAGGER EXPIRATION DATES OF ALL 1991/92 LICENSES AND PERMITS; AND AMENDING CHAPTER 15 OF THE CITY CODE TO INCREASE THE FOREIGN TRAVEL VACCINATION CERTIFICATION FEES FROM \$15.00 TO \$25.00 PER CERTIFICATION AND \$5.00 PER VACCINATION WITH AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$10.00 FOR VACCINATION.

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WHEREAS, the City Code now provides that all food related licenses and permits expire May 31st of each year; and

WHEREAS, this annual expiration date for all food permits and licenses results in an inefficient use of manpower and delays in issuing licenses renewals; and

WHEREAS, renewal of food licenses and permits on a basis of one (1) year from purchase of the original license is the accepted practice in the food industry; and

WHEREAS, the City Code now allows the Health Department to charge a fee for the issuance of a Foreign Travel Vaccination Certificate; and

WHEREAS, the current fee does not reflect the cost of providing this service; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 13, Article II, Section 13-35 of the City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 13-35. Form, Expiration.

Such licenses shall be issued under the corporate seal of the City, signed by the Director of Public Health, and shall authorize the person therein named to establish, maintain and operate a food establishment at the place designated in such license. Such license shall expire in the month one (1) year from the date of original issuance or renewal, and shall be renewed in each successive year thereafter.

SECTION 2. Chapter 13, Article II, Section 13-41. Prorating fees, shall be deleted in its entirety.

SECTION 3. Chapter 13, Article VIII, Section 13-203 of the City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 13-203. Annual renewal of permits.

Permits for operation of food service establishments shall be issued under the corporate seal of the City, signed by the Director of Public Health, and shall authorize the person therein named to establish, maintain and operate a food service establishment at the place designated in such permit. Such permit shall expire in the month one (1) year from the date of original issuance or renewal, and shall be renewed in each successive year thereafter.

SECTION 4. Chapter 13, Article VIII, Section 13-204(c) of the City Code shall be deleted in its entirety.

SECTION 5. Chapter 13, Article X, Division 1., Section 13-259 of the City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 13-259 License required.

Licenses for operation of any slaughter house, or any meat, meat products, or meat food products processing, fabricating, distribution, storage or retail outlet in which meat, meat products or meat food products capable of being used for human consumption are sold, offered for sale, stored or prepared for transportation or sale in the City, shall be issued under the corporate seal of the City, signed by the Director of Public Health, and shall authorize the person therein named to establish, maintain and operate a slaughter house, or any meat, meat products or meat food products processing, fabricating, distribution, storage, or retail outlet at the place designated in such license. Such license shall expire in the month one (1) year from the date of issuance or renewal, and shall be renewed in each successive year thereafter.

SECTION 6. Chapter 13, Article X, Division 1, Section 13-260-(6) of the City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

- (6) Pre-packaged consumer outlet. A pre-packaged consumer outlet shall be one in which inspected meat, meat products or meat food products are received, stored and sold directly to the ultimate consumer in the original sealed container bearing an inspection legend approved by the health authority. When a pre-packaged consumer outlet complies with the requirements of Division 2, he may be issued a food establishment license which stated thereon will allow him to conduct such operation. An additional fee shall be charged based upon the total number of persons working in the entire establishment and shall be as follows:

- a. Less than two (2) employees.....\$20.00
- b. Two (2) to five (5) employees.....\$25.00
- c. Six (6) to ten (10) employees.....\$30.00
- d. Over ten (10) employees.....\$35.00

This fee period shall coincide with the Retail Food Store License year.

SECTION 7. Chapter 13, Article X, Division 1, Sections 13-261(b), 13-261(c) and 23-261(d) of the City Code shall be deleted in their entirety.

SECTION 8. Chapter 13, Article X, Division 2, Section 13-300(c) of the City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

- (c) All fees listed in Subsection (b) of this Section, shall be payable to the City, and shall accompany the application for license. License for operation of a rendering business shall be issued under the corporate seal of the City, shall be signed by the Director of Public Health and shall authorize the person therein named to establish, maintain and operate a rendering business at the place designated in such licenses. Such licenses shall expire in the month one (1) year from the date of original issuance or renewal, and shall be renewed in each successive year thereafter.

SECTION 9. Chapter 13, Article XII, Section 13-357 of the City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 13-157. Permit renewal.

Permits, as required by Chapter 8, Section 101 of the "Retail Food Store Sanitation Code" shall be issued under the corporate seal of the City, signed by the Director of Public Health and shall authorize the person therein named to establish, maintain and operate a retail food store at the place designated in such permit. Such permit shall expire in the month one (1) year from the date of original issuance or renewal, and shall be renewed in each successive year thereafter.

SECTION 10. The Director of Public Health shall have the authority to renew all food related licenses and permits that expire May 31, 1991 for less than one (1) year in order to stagger the expiration date, and these expiration dates shall become the renewal date thereafter. All food related licenses and permits renewed for less than one year, during this staggering process, shall pay a prorated amount of the annual fee required. This prorated rate will equal one-twelfth of the annual licenses or permit charge for each month the licenses or permit is issued or renewed for.

SECTION 11. Chapter 15, Article I, Section 15-2(b) of the City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

(b) A fee in the amount of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per Foreign Travel Vaccination Certification is hereby established for all persons requesting such vaccination certificates from the Health Department. Individuals who receive foreign travel vaccinations from the Health Department will reimburse the Health Department for the actual cost of the vaccine used, plus five dollars (\$5.00) per vaccination with a maximum of ten dollars (\$10.00) regardless of the number of vaccinations received, in addition to the certification fee. Fees collected under this section shall be deposited into the City General Fund.

SECTION 12. All other provision of Chapters 13 and 15 of the City Code shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

SECTION 13. The effective date of this ordinance shall be October 1, 1990.

SECTION 14. The City Code is hereby authorized to be amended as necessary to contain the amendments contained herein.
