**MC-653** AN ORDINANCE

Releasing contractor and sureties on Construction and Maintenance Bonds of contract to pave Rusk Street, by the Uvalde Rock Asphalt Company.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, by an ordinance passed on the 27th day of January, 1916 accepted the bid of the Uvalde Rock Asphalt Company to pave Rusk Street, and in accordance therewith four copies of a contract for such paving were prepared, signed and bonded by said contractor, but were not approved by the Mayor and Finance Committee; and

WHEREAS, it has been mutually agreed between the City and the Contractor that said improvements stipulated in said contract be abandoned:

This is therefore to witness, that the City of San Antonio, through its Mayor and Commissioners, hereby releases said Uvalde Rock Asphalt Company and its said sureties on the Construction and maintenance bonds of said contract, from any and all obligations contained therein, and it is ordered that said contract be cancelled and held for naught.
