

AN ORDINANCE 64018

PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE SAN ANTONIO CITY LIMITS BY THE ANNEXATION OF APPROXIMATELY 115 ACRES OF LAND KNOWN AS THE BLANCO ROAD WEST AREA #1 PROPERTY AND APPROVING A SERVICE PLAN FOR SUCH AREA.

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of October, 1986, and on the 23rd day of October, 1986, the City Council of the City of San Antonio held public hearings on the proposed annexation of approximately 115 acres of land known as the Blanco Road West Area #1 property situated immediately adjacent to the current corporate limits; and such public hearings gave all interested persons the right to appear and be heard on the proposed annexation of such land; and

WHEREAS, on 21st day of October, 1986, an additional public hearing was held concerning that approximate 115 acre tract known as Blanco Road West Area #1 giving all interested persons the right to appear and be heard on the proposed annexation of such land; and

WHEREAS, notice of the above referenced public hearings was published in the San Antonio Light on October 5, 1986, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of San Antonio, Texas, and within the territory to be annexed, in accordance with law, and

WHEREAS, both of the aforementioned public hearings were conducted not more than forty (40) days nor less than twenty (20) days prior to the institution of annexation proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the population of the City of San Antonio, Texas is in excess of 800,000 inhabitants, and the area to be annexed lies within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of San Antonio, Texas, and lies adjacent to and adjoins the City of San Antonio, Texas, NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The land and territory lying adjacent to and adjoining the City of San Antonio known as the Blanco Road West Area #1 property more particularly described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby added and annexed to the City of San Antonio, Texas, and said territory as described shall hereafter be included within the boundary limits of said City, and the present boundary limits of said City, at the various points contiguous to the area described in Exhibit A are altered and amended so as to include said area within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, Texas.

SECTION 2. The land and territory known as the Blanco Road West Area #1, property so described and so annexed shall be part of the City of San Antonio, Texas, and the property so added shall bear its share of the taxes levied by the City of San Antonio, Texas, and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all of the rights and the privileges of all the citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of the City of San Antonio, Texas.

SECTION 3. A service plan outlining the provision of necessary municipal services to the property described in Exhibit A is hereby approved and the implementation of said plan is hereby authorized. Such plan is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit B.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective from and after December 29, 1986.

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## EXHIBIT A

A boundary description for an annexation area containing 115 acres of land, more, or less, and being adjacent to the city limits of the City of San Antonio to the north and being more particularly described as follows.

Beginning at the point of intersection of the southeast right-of-way line of Thrush Ridge and the northeast right-of-way line of Bitters Road.

THENCE: In a southwesterly direction along an extension of the southeast right-of-way line of Thrush Ridge across the R.O.W. of Bitters Road to a point on the southwest right-of-way line of Bitters Road and the city limits line of the City of San Antonio.

THENCE: In a northwesterly direction along the southwest right-of-way line of Bitters Road and the city limits line of the City of San Antonio to a point of intersection at the south right-of-way line of Bitters Road and the east right-of-way line of Huebner Road.

THENCE: In a southwesterly direction with the city limits line of the City of San Antonio along a line (from the point of intersection of the southern right-of-way line of Bitters Road and the east right-of-way line of Huebner Road to a point on the south boundary line of the City of Shavano Park being the Shavano Park city limits line and being the easternmost corner of the City of Shavano Park.) to its point of intersection with the east boundary line of a 53.747 acre tract described as P-1E out of C.B. 4785.

THENCE: In a northerly direction along said east boundary line of that 53.747 acre tract P-1E out of C.B. 4785 to a point on the south right-of-way line of Bitters Road same being the northeast corner of P-1E, C.B. 4785.

THENCE: A northerly direction across the R.O.W. of Bitters Road to a point on the north right-of-way line of Bitters Road same being the southwest corner of a 0.989 acre tract being P-3F out of C.B. 4786 and also being the Fire Station No. 43 tract.

THENCE: In a northerly direction along the west boundary line of said P-3F, C.B. 4786 to the northwest corner of said P-3F, C.B. 4786 said point also being a corner on the west boundary line of a 27.108 acre tract being P-3C out of C.B. 4786.

THENCE: In a northerly direction along the west boundary line of P-3C, C.B. 4786 to the northwest corner of P-3C, C.B. 4786 same being the southwest corner of P-3A, C.B. 4786.

THENCE: In a southeasterly direction along the north boundary line of P-3C, C.B. 4786 same being the south boundary line of P-3A, C.B. 4786 to a point on the northwest right-of-way line of Huebner Road.

THENCE: In a northeasterly direction along the northwest right-of-way line of Huebner Road to its point of intersection with a line perpendicular to a point on the southeast right-of-way line of Huebner Road said point being the westernmost corner of a varying width drainage R.O.W. and sanitary sewer easement as platted in the Deerfield Subdivision Unit 4.

THENCE: In a southeasterly direction along said perpendicular line across the R.O.W. of Huebner Road to a point on the southeast right-of-way line of Huebner Road said point being the westernmost corner of said drainage R.O.W. and sanitary sewer easement.

THENCE: S27°29'04"W a distance of 41.39 feet.

THENCE: N40°16'00"W a distance of 59.40 feet.

THENCE: S81°01'56"W a distance of 89.52 feet to the P.C. of a curve to the right.

THENCE: Curve right along the arc of said curve having a radius of 360 feet a distance of 402.57 feet.

THENCE: S16°57'42"E a distance of 151.51 feet.

THENCE: S28°28'42"E a distance of 265.63 feet to the P.C. of a curve to the right.

THENCE: Curve right along the arc of said curve having a radius of 50 feet a distance of 92.57 feet.

THENCE: S77°35'44"W a distance of 285.37 feet to the P.C. of a curve to the right.


THENCE: Curve right along the arc of said curve having a radius of 485.00 feet a distance of 52.91 feet.

THENCE: S83°50'44"W a distance of 225.00 feet to a point on the northeast right-of-way line of Thrush Ridge.

THENCE: In a southeasterly then southwesterly direction along the northeast then the southeast right-of-way line of Thrush Ridge to its point of intersection with the northeast right-of-way line of Bitters Road and the point of beginning for this annexation area containing 115 acres of land more less.

ANNEXATION MUNICIPAL SERVICES PLAN TERMS AND PROVISIONS FOR

BLANCO ROAD WEST (AREAS #1)

1. This service plan shall be valid for ten (10) years.
2. This Plan shall not be subject to amendment or repeal unless the City Council determines that changed conditions or subsequent occurrences make the plan unworkable or obsolete. If the City Council determines that all or part of a plan is unworkable or obsolete it may amend the plan to conform to changed conditions or subsequent occurrences.

An amended service plan shall provide for services comparable to or better than those established in the service plan before amendment, and before any amendment is adopted, the City Council shall first provide an opportunity for all interested persons to be heard at a public hearing called and held in the manner provided in Section 10, Article 970a, VTCS as amended.

3. Renewal shall be at the discretion of the City.

SIXTY DAY MUNICIPAL SERVICES PLAN FOR BLANCO ROAD WEST (AREA #1)

Effective Date: February 27, 1987

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SERVICE	SERVICES TO BE EXTENDED UPON ANNEXATION
Police	The San Antonio Police Department will respond to calls for assistance, enforcement, and protection immediately upon the effective date of annexation, December 29, 1986.
Fire protection	The San Antonio Fire Department will respond to calls for assistance immediately upon the effective date of annexation, December 29, 1986.  The primary responding station shall be Station #43 located on Bitters Road, 1000 feet west of Huebner Road. Back-up protection, as necessary, will be provided by Stations #31, 11802 West Avenue and Station #14, 1855 Thousand Oaks.
Solid waste collection	The San Antonio Environmental Management Department shall provide for collection of solid waste twice weekly on a regular route by February 27, 1987.  A fee of \$7.00 will be assessed. This fee may be changed by the City Council with proper notice. Commercial service shall be made available upon request. If service is not desired, private service is permissible.  Brush pick-up shall be made in accordance with City wide schedule.  Dead animal pick-up is available upon request.
Street, drainage and public improvement maintenance	All public improvements which have been properly platted, duly dedicated, and accepted by the City of San Antonio shall be maintained by the Department of Public Works.

SIXTY DAY MUNICIPAL SERVICES PLAN FOR BLANCO ROAD (AREA #1)

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SERVICE	SERVICES TO BE EXTENDED UPON ANNEXATION
Street lights, street name signs and traffic control	Public street lights will be maintained by City Public Service.  Traffic control devices and street name signs will be maintained by the Department of Public Works.
Public wastewater facilities	Public Wastewater facilities will be maintained by the City of San Antonio in accordance with the Subdivision Regulations, Chapter 30 of the City Code.
Public water facilities	Public water facilities will be maintained by City Water Board.
Maintenance of public parks and recreational facilities.	There are no existing municipal parks or recreational facilities within this area.
Maintenance of municipally owned facilities, buildings	Municipally owned facilities and buildings will be maintained by the City of San Antonio.
Zoning	Effective December 29, 1986, all property will be zoned Temporary "R-1" Single Family Residential.  All requests for rezoning may be made through the City's Department of Planning in accordance with the City's Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 35 of the City Code.
Building permits	Effective December 29, 1986, all proposed or incomplete construction must obtain a building permit from the Department of Building Inspections in accordance with Chapter 6 of the City Code.

SIXTY DAY MUNICIPAL SERVICES PLAN FOR BLANCO ROAD WEST (AREA #1)

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SERVICE	SERVICES TO BE EXTENDED UPON ANNEXATION
Certificates of occupancy and related licenses	Effective December 29, 1986, new and existing businesses must obtain a Certificate of Occupancy and related licenses from the Department of Building Inspections in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 35 of the City Code.
Nonconforming rights	To establish nonconforming rights for zoning, existing non-single family uses must register by December 29, 1987 with the Department of Building Inspections. A Certificate of Occupancy will be issued certifying the use including any home occupations which are located in a single family dwelling unit.  A building permit must be obtained for incomplete construction. The permit must be applied for by February 27, 1987, through the Department of Building Inspections.  Non-conforming rights to allow proposed construction must be filed by February 27, 1987 with the Department of Planning in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 35 of the City Code.
Code enforcement	The Department of Building Inspections will respond to requests for inspection of suspected City Code violations including, but not limited to, the zoning ordinance, building code, sign ordinance, and junk car ordinance.
Other municipal services	All other services available to residents of the City of San Antonio including, but not limited to, health, animal control, library, and human resources shall be provided to this area in the same manner as to other areas of the City.

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SERVICE

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Water	Water service to the area will be provided in accordance with the City Water Board's <u>Regulations for Water Service</u> as may be amended in the future.
Gas and electricity	Gas and electricity service is available in accordance with existing City Public Service policies, and capacities, and dependent upon developer schedules and requirements.
Wastewater	Wastewater service is available to property owners/developers from the City of San Antonio in accordance with the Subdivision Regulations, Chapter 30 of the City Code.
Street lights	New street lights will be installed at the intersections of residential streets and at other locations as determined by the Department of Public Works.
Traffic control devices	New traffic control devices will be installed as determined by the Department of Public Works.
Public parks and recreational facilities	Public parks and recreation facilities may be acquired and developed in accordance with the Department of Parks and Recreation Master Plan and with City Council approval.
