

## MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, JUNE 24TH, A.D. 1920, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Heuermann, Wright.  
Absent, Lambert.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

## ----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Petition of Miller and Covell, for permit to install gasoline tank was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Petition of Diocese of West Texas for correction of assessment was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxatio,

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Streets, etc.  
For sanitary sewers in Birch Street.  
A.L. Houston, with reference to Sanitary Sewers to be constructed in Palm Heights Addition, was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

Bids of Travis Electric Co., Hraham & Collins, Phillips and Crowther, Schroeder Electric Company, Wright Bros, Thomson Electric Co. Kirkwood and Wharton, for wiring and electric equipment for four new Fire Department Stations, and the annex of Central Police and Fire Station, were opened and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police, City Electrician and Building Inspector.

Bid of Firestone Co. for furnishing two solid tires for Fire Department equipment were opened and referred to City Purchasing Agent.
