

AN ORDINANCE 2014 - 09 - 04 - 0656

**AUTHORIZING THE SETTLEMENT OF A LAWSUIT STYLED *LLANES*
v. *CITY OF SAN ANTONIO*; CAUSE NO. 2012-CI-20373, IN THE 224TH
JUDICIAL DISTRICT, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS FOR PAYMENT IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$110,000.00.**

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2011, Adriana Llanes was injured when the vehicle she was occupying was struck by a City of San Antonio vehicle driven by Edward Cruz, an SAPD crime technician; and

WHEREAS, Adriana Llanes alleges personal injuries and lost income resulting from the collision; and

WHEREAS, although the City of San Antonio has vigorously contested liability in this matter, it is in its best interest to settle this matter to avoid the uncertainty and risks associated with further litigation; and

WHEREAS, the parties have mediated this case and reached an agreed settlement in the amount of \$110,000.00, contingent upon City Council approval; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1: Funding in the amount of \$110,000.00 for this ordinance is available for Fund 75001000, Cost Center 0709020010 and General Ledger 5402530, as part of the Fiscal Year 2014 Budget.

SECTION 2: Payment is authorized to be made payable as follows: \$110,000.00 will be paid to Adriana Llanes and her attorney, Paul Campolo as settlement of Cause No. 2012-CI-20373 styled *Llanes v. The City of San Antonio*.

SECTION 3: The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


