AN ORDINANCE (851)

APPROPRIATING \$75.00 IN PAYMENT OF CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES ON ACCOUNT OF PERSONAL INJURIES TO MELVENE NOETTA KELLER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1.
