

AN ORDINANCE **2011-04-21-0321**

AUTHORIZING THE RENAMING OF A REALIGNED PORTION OF "E. THEO AVENUE" TO "THEO PARKWAY" BETWEEN "MISSION ROAD" AND THE DEAD-END OF CONCEPCION PARK.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, as part of the Mission Reach portion of the San Antonio River Improvement Project, San Antonio River Authority (SARA) will construct a portal in Concepcion Park which will provide direct pedestrian access from the San Antonio River to Concepcion Park, National Park Service property and Mission Concepcion. Construction of the portal will require physical closure and removal of an existing portion of E. Theo Avenue; and

WHEREAS, due to the partial closure and realignment of E. Theo Avenue, an existing section of E. Theo Avenue (beginning at Mission Road and ending at the dead-end of Concepcion Park) is proposed to be renamed Theo Parkway. The rationale behind this is to enhance flow of traffic patterns, avoid public confusion and to ensure public safety; and

WHEREAS, this street renaming process has been coordinated through City Council District 3 Office, the US Postal Services, Metro 911, San Antonio Fire, Parks and Recreation, Public Works Departments, the City Attorney's Office, and the Department of Development Services; and

WHEREAS, this request was presented to the City Council Governance Committee and public process has been followed; **NOW THEREFORE:**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The city-owned street known as E. Theo Avenue is hereby renamed Theo Parkway between Mission Road and the dead-end of Concepcion Park. City staff is directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.

SECTION 2. The financial impact is anticipated between \$1,000-\$1,500 which will be covered through the Department of Parks and Recreation.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective on the 1st day of May, 2011.

PASSED AND APPROVED this 21st day of April, 2011.




