

AN ORDINANCE **88293**

ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF PART-TIME MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE JESSE A. SEPULVEDA, JR.; DECLARING A VACANCY IN THE POSITION HE HELD; AND AUTHORIZING THE RECRUITMENT AND SUBSEQUENT SELECTION OF QUALIFIED AND INTERESTED INDIVIDUALS TO FILL THE VACANCY CREATED BY THE RESIGNATION OF JUDGE SEPULVEDA, AS REQUESTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL MUNICIPAL COURT COMMITTEE.

**WHEREAS**, part-time Municipal Court Judge Jesse A. Sepulveda, Jr., by letter dated June 30, 1998, tendered his resignation as a part-time Municipal Court Judge; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary for the City Council of the City of San Antonio to accept the resignation of Judge Sepulveda, declare a vacancy in the position he held, and authorize the recruitment and subsequent selection of qualified and interested individuals to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Judge Sepulveda, as requested by the City Council Municipal Court Committee in its memorandum dated August 6, 1998, attached hereto as Exhibit A; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The resignation of part-time Municipal Court Judge Jesse A. Sepulveda, Jr., is hereby accepted.

**SECTION 2.** A vacancy is hereby declared to exist in the position held by Judge Sepulveda, and the recruitment and subsequent selection of qualified and interested individuals to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Judge Sepulveda is hereby authorized.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage hereof.


