

- - - JANUARY 8, 1943. - - -

The City Council of the City of San Antonio met in adjourned session at 5 P.M., January 8, 1943, pursuant to a call for said meeting signed by all of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio .

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro Tempore Henry F. Hein who announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of inducting the Honorable Gus B. Mauermann into office as Mayor of the City of San Antonio, and he announced that the oath of office would be administered by Judge C. K. Quin, Judge of 57th District Court of Bexar County, Texas.

The oath of office being duly administered, the installing officer declared Gus B. Mauermann duly installed as Mayor of San Antonio, Texas.

Whereupon Mayor Mauermann addressed the Commissioners and audience in a sound and vigorous manner, his remarks meeting with great enthusiasm and applause.

Before being inducted into office Gus B. Mauermann had tendered to Commissioner P. L. Anderson, Fire and Police Commissioner, and the Fire and Police Civil Service Board his resignation as Chairman of the Fire and Police Civil Service Board and a like resignation to Mayor Pro Tempore Henry F. Hein and the City Commissioners as a member of the Zoning Commission of the City of San Antonio; both of which resignations were accepted.

Mayor Mauermann announced the following changes and appointments in the Mayor's department of the City of San Antonio, viz;

W. C. Petry, Private Secretary,

William Steinhardt, Executor of New Municipal Airport.

The meeting was then adjourned as of January 8th, 1943.
