

AN ORDINANCE 2012-04-05-0239

**REAPPOINTING SAN ANTONIO MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES FOR
TWO-YEAR TERMS OF OFFICE BEGINNING MAY 1, 2012.**

* * * * *

WHEREAS, City Council previously appointed full-time Municipal Court Judges whose terms of office will expire April 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Presiding Judge John Bull has conducted an evaluation of each Judge and based on his review and confirmation of eligibility to continue to serve as Municipal Court Judges, recommends that the existing full-time Judges be reappointed; and

WHEREAS, City Council also appoints part-time Municipal Court Judges to supplement the courts on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, after review and consideration of the performance of the existing full-time Judges, the City Council finds that is in the best interest of the City to make the following appointments and to seek applications for part-time Municipal Court Judges; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following persons are appointed to serve as full-time Judges for the City of San Antonio Municipal Court effective May 1, 2012 to April 30, 2014:

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is directed to post an advertisement seeking applicants for part-time Municipal Court Judges who shall be subject to future appointment by City Council.

SECTION 3. Annual salaries for the full-time Municipal Court Judges are established at \$101,290.00. Life insurance and health and retirement benefits currently extended to City employees are extended to the full-time Municipal Court Judges.

SECTION 4. Funding for this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 0301010001, General Ledger 5101010. The amounts will be encumbered upon issuance of a purchase order, and payment is authorized to the individuals listed in Section 1 of this ordinance. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2012 budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.




