## AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$325.00 to pay W.L. Beatty for balance due on sanitary sewer on University Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Three Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Sewer Construction Department, 1922 General Fund, to pay W.L. Beatty balance due on sanitary sewer laid by W.L. Beatty, on University Avenue, between Brazos and Meridian Streets, it being necessary for the City to acquire this amount in advance of paving in order to have all property owners connected.
