

AN ORDINANCE **2010-01-14-0027**

**AUTHORIZING THE FOURTH AMENDMENT TO  
THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT  
FOR FEDERAL REPRESENTATION SERVICES  
WITH PATTON BOGGS LLP, EXTENDING THE  
TERM THROUGH APRIL 30, 2010.**

**WHEREAS**, since April 2005, City Council has retained Patton Boggs L.L.P. (“Patton Boggs”) to represent the City of San Antonio on a wide variety of legislative and regulatory issues in Washington, D.C. including transportation, housing, and community development, education, public health and any additional issues the City determines to be necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, Patton Boggs currently represents the City in connection with adoption of the City’s 2010 Federal Legislative program, assists the City with direct appropriations or earmarks, which represent a significant portion of the City’s 2010 Federal Legislative Program, and assists the City with identifying new grant and Recovery Act funding opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is presently engaged in a competitive process to select a new federal representation firm; and

**WHEREAS**, the current Federal Representation Services Contract with Patton Boggs expired on December 31, 2009 and in order to maintain federal representation continuity through the commencement of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Session of the 111<sup>th</sup> Congress, staff recommends that the existing contract be amended to provide for an expiration date of the sooner of April 30, 2010 or the effective date of the professional services agreement for the incoming federal representation firm; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The terms and conditions of the Fourth Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement for Federal Representation Services with Patton Boggs L.L.P. are authorized and approved.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute the Fourth Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement for Federal Representation Services with Patton Boggs L.L.P. A copy of the Fourth Amendment, previously executed by Patton Boggs, is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit I.

**SECTION 3.** Funding for this Ordinance in an amount up to \$48,000.00 is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 0801010001, General Ledger 5201040, as part of the Fiscal Year 2010 Budget.

**SECTION 4.** Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized and shall be encumbered with a purchase order.

**SECTION 5.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the passage of eight (8) affirmative votes. If it is not passed by (8) affirmative votes, this Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage.


