

AN ORDINANCE 81 65 5

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF DISCRETIONARY FUNDS AS REQUESTED BY MAYOR NELSON WOLFF AND COUNCILMAN ROGER PEREZ TO ASSIST IN A \$40,000.00 DEBT REDUCTION FOR THE MILAM PARK REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

**WHEREAS,** Mayor Nelson Wolff and Councilman Roger Perez have requested that funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 each from their respective discretionary fund accounts be approved by the City Council for use in completing the Milam Park Redevelopment Project; and

**WHEREAS,** Mayor Wolff and Councilman Perez have appealed to other councilmembers to contribute to the project, which has incurred unplanned archaeological costs and the loss of financial contributions from Mexico for the kiosk construction expenses; and

**WHEREAS,** the estimated additional expenses are \$40,000.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

SECTION 1. The expenditure of the funds listed below in the sum of \$ 11,160.00 from various district discretionary accounts to defray the cost of completing the work of the Milam Park Redevelopment Project, is hereby authorized and approved. A copy of the memo request by Mayor Nelson Wolff and Councilman Roger A. Perez for such contributions from councilmembers is attached and incorporated herein as "Attachment I". We are requesting that an ordinance be placed on the February 9, 1995 City Council Agenda which would allow the commitment of \$5,000 from each of our two Discretionary Accounts to assist in a \$40,000 debt reduction for the Milam Park Project, and ask that you consider any contribution you might make to this project.

As you know, Milam Park has recently undergone extensive renovation led by the Friends of Milam Park. Two events early in the project impacted the overall budget with unanticipated expenses. These were the finding of the Ben Milam remains which greatly increased the archaeological costs, and the unfortunate circumstances in Jalisco, Mexico which reduced their support cost contribution for the kiosk.
