Petition for improvement of East End Park was read and referred to Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks and Public Property.

Petition of Motor Oil Company for permit to install gasoline pump and tank at Pecan and St. Mary Street was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Petition of citizens on Montana, East Commerce and Mohawk Streets for sanitary sewers in alleys, was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements:
