---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS.---

The following petition was read and referred to the Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements:

Petition of Citizens for sanitary sewer in Dunning Avenue.

The following Resolution was introduced and adopted:

RESOLUTION

Advertising for bids for resurfacing East Commerce street between Chestnut street and Alamo street, between the Street Railway Company's right-of-way and the North boundary line of said street.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City Clerk is hereby directed to advertise for bids for resurfacing East Commerce street between Chestnut street and Alamo street between the right-of-way of the street railway Company and the North boundary line of said street, with either one of the following materials, to-wit:

(1) Creosoted wood block; (2) Bitulithic, and (3). Uvalde Rock Asphalt, in accordance with plans and specifications to be seen in the office of the City Engineer.

A Certified check or Cashier's check in the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, made payable to Sam C. Bell, Mayor, must accompany each proposal. All bids shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk on or before 4:00 P.M. on January 9th, 1919.
