Carnegie granted Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to the City of San Antonio, to be used for the erection of a public library; and such a library was built on the corner of Presa and Market Streets, across the San Antonio River from LA VILLITA (since that time the City of San Antonio has acquired that district known as "LA VILLITA", all as set out in The Villita Ordinance", passed and approved on October 12, 1939); and,

WHEREAS, every effort is being made by the City of San Antonio to restore and re-create LA VILLITA as a project of the City of San Antonio, one of the purposes of LA VILLITA being the promotion of world peace by promoting peace, friendship and justice between the nations of the western hemisphere, at least partially according to the precepts of the great Andrew J. Carnegie; and,

WHEREAS, the Carnegie Corporation has, at a meeting of its Executive Committee

held in New York City on December 19, 1939, appropriated the sum of \$15,000.00 toward the Villita Project in the City of San Antonio, Texas; and it is the desire of the City of San Antonio to officially obligate itself to spend this sum of money in accordance with the objectives of the Villita Project and also the ideals of Andrew J. Carnegie and of the Carnegie Corporation; NOW, THEREFORE:-

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

That the City of San Antonio hereby accepts the Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) so appropriated and requests the Carnegie Corporation to forward such sum to the City of San Antonio for the account of "LA VILLITA".

That said sum of money shall be used for the Villita Project only and for the purpose of establishing an Hispanic-American Library and Art Museum and Community Center of such Project being for the promotion of world peace, the promotion of arts and crafts, for research, study and promotion of Spanish and Southwestern culture, and for other purposes in accordance with the Villita Ordinance.

That this Ordinance, having been passed unanimously, shall be signed by the Mayor and all of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, in duplicate original; that one original be forwarded to the Carnegie Corporation of New York, and that a copy of the ordinance be spread on the Minutes of the Proceedings of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, and that a copy of this Ordinance be also spread in the LA VILLITA REGISTER.
