The following Ordinance

" AN ORDINANCE

PROVIDING FOR EXTENSION OF THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN ADDITIONAL TERRITORY ADJACENT TO THE NORTHERN BOUNDS OF THE CITY "

having been introduced, and no amendments desired by the Commissioners, it is ready for final passage as it is, and it is ordered that it shall be published in the San Antonio Evening News, a daily newspaper published in the City of San Antonio, one time, and shall not be passed finally until at least 30 days have elapsed after said publication.

The vote was as follows: Ayes, Mauermann, Hein and Anderson. Nays: Steffler (Absent) and Callaghan.

Commissioner Anderson announced that Commissioner Steffler's absence was due to illness, and asked that he be excused from attendance at the meeting.

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson, seconded by Commissioner Hein, requesting the City Attorney to draw up an Ordinance placing a uniform fare on all bus lines operating within the present City limits for the duration of the war, in conformity with a letter received by Commissioner Paul E. Steffler from the San Antonio Transit Company, which motion was unanimously approved.

After an exchange of good wishes for the New Year, upon motion by Commissioner Hein, seconded by Commissioner Callaghan and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned December 30th, 1943.
