

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, JANUARY 30TH, A.D.1922, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable O. B. Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police:

For arc light New Braunfels Avenue and Allensworth Street.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation: Dave Lehr, for cancellation of taxes on auto. Back Tax Collector, for cancellation of taxes on Lot 46, C.B.843.

Petition of property owners on Buena Vista Street to have same paved was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

Commissioner Lambert introduced the following resolution, which was read and adopted:

RESOLUTION

Authorizing and permitting the Fiesta Association to stage a pageant in San Pedro Park, during the week known as Fiesta Week.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section one: That the Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements is hereby authorized to purchase from Lewis-Patton Company, two eight foot road-graders, for the price of \$250.00 each.

Section Two: The sum of \$500.00 out of the 1921 General Fund to be charged to the Department of Streets, is hereby appropriated to pay Lewis-Patton Company, for the two eight foot road graders, the purchase of which is authorized by Section One hereof.

Communication from S.A. Trades Council requesting that adequate appropriation be made for the support of the Carnegie Library, was read and ordered filed.

Members of the Board of Trustees of the Carnegie Library addressed the Commissioners regarding the necessity for an increased appropriation by the City for the support of the Library, and the making of certain repairs. The Mayor announced that the Commissioners would give the matter earnest consideration and endeavor to meet the requirements of the institution.

On recommendation of the City Purchasing Agent the bid of the S.A. Sewer Pipe Mfg. Co. for supplying the City with sewer pipe was accepted.

Altering, changing and amending Section Two of an ordinance passed and approved on the first day of December, 1921, and recorded in Ordinance Book "F" pages 599-605,, entitled "An ordinance for the purpose of regulating local street transportation of persons by jitneys, motorbuses and other vehicles for such transportation on the streets of the City of San Antonio, except as herein provided for, and providing appropriate penalties," so that said Section Two of said ordinance as amended, shall permit the use of other and additional streets over which jitneys, motorbuses and other vehicles may be operated for the purpose of local street transportation of persons; and shall hereafter read and provide as follows;
