

JUNE 8, 1944

REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE CITY HALL, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, AT 10:00 O'CLOCK, A.M., on THURSDAY, JUNE 8th, 1944.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson. Mayor Mauermann presiding.

On motion of Commissioner Anderson, seconded by Commissioner Callaghan, and carried by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson, the Council postponed the regular order of business in order to proceed at once to ceremonies of accepting and hanging the portrait of former Mayor Maury Maverick. Mayor Mauermann made the acceptance address, followed by remarks by Commissioners Hein and Anderson. Former Mayor Maverick, who was unable to be present, was represented by his father, Mr. Albert Maverick, Sr., and other members of his family. Acting as spokesman for the family, Mr. Jim Maverick, brother of the former Mayor, accepted the portrait in behalf of former Mayor Maverick. The portrait was placed in the space reserved for it on the wall of the Council Chamber, alongside the portraits of other former mayors of San Antonio.

The City Clerk read the minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 25th, 1944, together with those of the Recessed Meetings of May 30th and 31st, and the minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 1st, 1944, together with those of the Recessed Meeting of June 3rd, which minutes were each approved, as read, on motion of Commissioner Hein, seconded by Commissioner Callaghan, and carried by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson.

Petition of Eunice F. Sweatts for permit to build barbecue pit at 911 Culebra Avenue.

Petition of H. Frank Jordan protesting the placing of a boiler by Mathieu Cleaners.

The Petition of Mr. W. P. Campbell on behalf of the Vestry of Christ Church, asking exemption of City taxes on Lots 19-20-21-22, N. C. B. 1862, was presented and referred to the Commissioner of Taxation for action.
