RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR REVOCABLE LICENSE FOR LAND FOR WIDENING OF EAST TRAVIS STREET AT THE POSTOFFICE SITE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the United States Government is requested hereby for a revocable license to be issued by the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States of America, for the use of two tracts of land in New City Block 425, for the widening of East Travis Street at the Postoffice site, said tracts of land being more particularly described as follows:

2. TRACT A:

Beginning at the intersection of the present east property line of North Alamo Street; and the present south line of East Travis Street; Thence in an easterly direction along the present south line of East Travis Street, a distance of 136.45 feet to a point; Thence in a southeasterly direction with an angle of 43° 21' turned to the right and along the southeasterly line of East Travis Street, a distance of 29.92 feet to a point; Thence in a northwesterly direction along the new established south line of East Travis Street, with a radius of 68 feet, a distance of 51.05 feet to a point in the new established south line of East Travis Street; Thence along the new established south line of East Travis Street, a distance of 111.97 feet to the new established east line of North Alamo Street; Thence

in a northerly direction along the new established east line of North Alamo Street, a distance of 0.4 feet to the point of beginning; containing 270.03 square feet.

3. TRACT B:

Beginning at the intersection of the west property line of Avenue "E" and the south property line of East Travis Street; Thence in a southerly direction along the west property line of Avenue "E", a distance of 7.0 feet; Thence in a northwesterly direction with a radius of 7.0 feet, a distance of 10.99 feet to the south property line of East Travis Street; Thence in a easterly direction along the south property line of East Travis Street, a distance of 7.0 feet to the point of beginning; containing 10.52 square feet.

4. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be sent to the Secretary of Treasury to support this request.

AN ORDINANCE *MM-149*

APPROPRIATING \$300.00 OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND 1933 - PARK AND PLAZAS DEPARTMENT TO PAY SHARE OF CITY OF SAN ANTONIO IN CIVIL WORKS PROJECT 596-C-6 FOR QUARRYING ROCKS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That \$300.00 is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund 1933 - Parks and Plazas Department, and will be available upon demand of the Civil Works Administration of Texas, to pay share of City of San Antonio in Local Project No. 596-C-6, Re-submitted, under the supervision of the Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks and Public Property, to quarry rock for walls and riprap, and to dig gravel for walks and street surfaces of the public streets in the City of San Antonio.

AN ORDINANCE *-150*

APPROPRIATING \$600.00 OUT OF FLOOD PREVENTION FUND OF 1924 TO PAY SHARE OF CITY OF SAN ANTONIO IN CIVIL WORKS PROJECT 4652-D-6 and 601-C-8 TO IMPROVE SAN PEDRO CREEK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That \$600.00 is hereby appropriated out of Flood Prevention Fund of 1924, and will be available upon demand of the Civil Works Administration of Texas, to pay the share of City of San Antonio in Local Project 4652-D-6 and 601-C-8, under the supervision of the Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks and Public Property, to be used for the purpose of improving the San Pedro Creek by repairing and changing the channel thereof, and by constructing walls along the same by lining the San Pedro Creek with rock retaining walls from the upper end of San Pedro Creek to Martin Street, approximately 8,000 feet, and the straightening of the channel from the Southern Pacific Railroad tracks, to the junction of the San Pedro Creek with the San Antonio River,

all in a permanent manner, to prevent or ameliorate flood conditions and protect the public health and safety.
