BE IT ORSAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, There be and there is hereby appropriated the sum of Eighteen and 50/100 (\$18.50) Dollars out of the Judgement Fund to pay Osceola Archer, District clerk, the amount of costs in causes Nos. AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the Mayor ~~MM~~ is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into a written contract on behalf of the City of San Antonio with S.A.Machine & Supply Company and the Decarie Incinerator Company, for the construction and erection of an incinerator on what is commonly as the Stevens property east of Camp Wilson and near the Salado, same to be constructed in accordance with the proposal of said companies and the plans and specifications on file in the office of the City Engineer; the contract price to be paid by the City to said companies for the construction of the incinerator, and the agreement made by them in connection therewith, is Fifteen Thousand, Two Hundred, Sixty four and 92/100 (\$15,264.92) Dollars.

The Mayor is further authorized and empowered to place in said contract the usual, customary and necessary agreements and provisions for the protection of the City and for the proper execution of the work. And there is hereby appropriated out of the Constructing Garbage Incinerator Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand, Two Hundred, Sixty four and 92/100 (\$15,264.92) Dollars, to be paid to said companies upon estimates, as provided for in the contract to be entered into between said companies and the City.

The contract shall in all things take the place of the contract heretofore entered into by and between the City and the Decarie Incinerator Company on June 28, 1915, and the City shall be by the terms of said contract in all things released from any further liability or responsibility for or under said contract of June 28, 1915.

AN ORDINANCE

City of San Antonio, Texas, granting owners of Harlandale Addition sewer stubs for future sewer laterals, connecting with City Sewer System.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, in accordance with an agreement for a sewer right-of-way through Harlandale Addition, given the City of San Antonio, Texas, by Mr. H.J.Benson, owner, permission is hereby granted to said H.J.Benson, to connect sewer laterals with sewer main traversing Harlandale addition, at all intersecting streets and alleys in said addition, and in a tract of 153 acres south of Harlandale which may be platted later. These stubs will be placed by the City in the main sewer, as required, upon written notice to the City Plumbing and Sewer Department, from the owners of Harlandale addition.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.
