

AN ORDINANCE 2013 - 01 - 31 - 0067

AUTHORIZING A TASK ORDER CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH INTERSTATE BARRICADES AND MARKINGS, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$860,735.00, TO PERFORM THE INSTALLATION OF PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND BIKE LANES FOR THE FY 2013 TASK ORDER CONTRACT FOR PAVEMENT MARKINGS.

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WHEREAS, the Pavement Markings contract will be utilized primarily to complete approximately 100 center line miles of pavement markings and 9 miles of bike lanes identified in the 2013 – 2017 Rolling 5 Year Infrastructure Management Program along with additional projects that materialize throughout the contract term and are within the contract capacity; and

WHEREAS, funding sources for individual work orders include, but are not limited to, General Fund, Advanced Transportation District Program, Annual Traffic Signal Program, and Neighborhood Access and Mobility Program funds; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes a Task Order Construction Contract with **Interstate Barricades and Markings, Inc.** in the total amount not to exceed \$860,735.00 to perform the installation of pavement markings and bike lanes for the FY 2013 Task Order Contract for Pavement Markings Project; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Task Order Construction Contract in the amount not to exceed \$860,735.00 is hereby approved. The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute this Task Order Contract with **Interstate Barricades and Markings, Inc.**

SECTION 2. The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Funding for this ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued. If funding for any work orders is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.
- b) Payment not to exceed \$860,735.00, is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to **Interstate Barricades and Markings, Inc.** for pavement markings and bike lane installation services.
- c) The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP

Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.






