

AN ORDINANCE 2013-02-21-0133

**AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT FOR CULTURE AND CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT TO SUBMIT GRANT APPLICATIONS AND ACCEPT ANY FUNDING AWARDED AS A RESULT OF THOSE APPLICATIONS FROM THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE ARTS AND THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON THE ARTS AND TO EXECUTE ANY ASSOCIATED AGREEMENTS FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF SUCH FUNDS, AND PROVIDING THE REQUIRED MATCH FOR SUCH GRANTS.**

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**WHEREAS**, the National Endowment for the Arts (“NEA”) and the Texas Commission on the Arts (“TCA”) offer annual funding opportunities to municipalities and local arts agencies and the Department for Culture and Creative Development (“DCCD”) believes that some of its programming and local arts agency projects it funds in the community are excellent fits for these grants; and

**WHEREAS**, DCCD looks for opportunities to enhance the funding it provides the local arts community through state, regional and national granting opportunities, such as the ones considered by this Ordinance; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee or the Director of DCCD is authorized to submit grant applications and accept grant funds (“Grant Funds”) upon award from the NEA and TCA. Copies of all the applications will be on file with DCCD upon submission.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee or the Director of DCCD is authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate the application, acceptance and expenditure of these grants. If required, the City Attorney’s Office shall draft and negotiate appropriate agreements based on the City’s standard templates. Any Grant Funds to be awarded as part of the Fiscal Year 2014 Arts Funding Process will be considered at a future date.

**SECTION 3.** If any Grant Funds are accepted for expenditure in the current fiscal year, any required matching funds will be provided from funds currently allocated in the Fiscal Year 2013 budget. Any required matching funds for such grants to be expended next fiscal year shall be allocated during the Fiscal Year 2014 budget process.

**SECTION 4.** Upon acceptance of these awards, new funds and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the award amounts will be appropriated from the NEA and TCA. Formal budgets will be provided upon acceptance of the awards.

**SECTION 5.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective ten days after its passage.




